### National Blood Donor Month

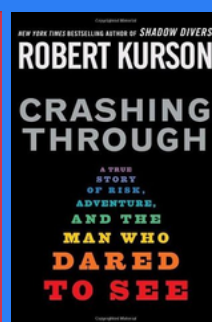
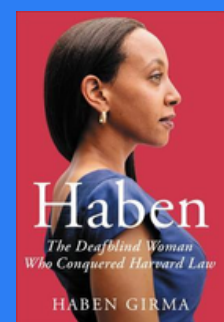
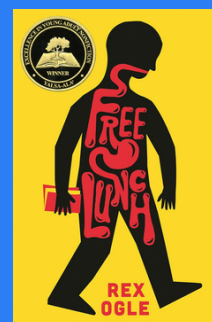
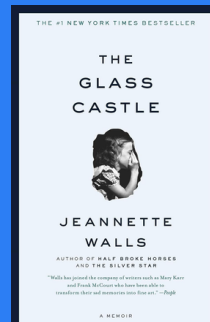
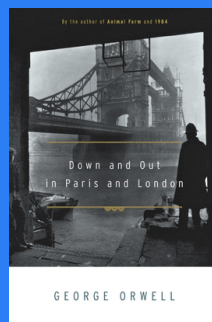
