## Recommended Qualifications

- Students can enroll in the program as a junior or senior.
- GPA of a 3.0 or higher is recommended.
- Interview process may be required.
- No discipline referrals.
- No more than ten absences per year.
- Must be able to handle a very structured environment, (rules, policies, procedures)
- Students are required to stay in the program for the entire school year.
- Ability to work independently and in a team environment
