

PRE NURSING/ HEALTHCARE SPECIALIST PATHWAY - CCMA



Program Overview

Students learn about the human body and its functions, along with triage situations encountered as a Medical Assistant such as working in a doctor's office, taking vitals (blood pressure, pulse, respiration, temperature, etc.), venipuncture, syringe fill, ECG's, urinalysis, prescription writing, and dosage calculations. Students may also earn CPR, HIPAA, FEMA, NHA CCMA, and Bloodborne Pathogen certifications.

Recommended Qualifications

- Open to Juniors and Seniors
- Health Science Education I as a **recommended** prerequisite and/or Anatomy and Physiology.
- Background check required.
- GPA of a 3.0 or higher is recommended.
- Interview process may be required.
- Drivers license and vehicle required for clinical site.
- Must be able to handle a very structured environment.
- Physical required by the end of the 1st month of school.
- Proof of vaccinations.
- No discipline referrals or out of school suspensions.
- No more than ten absences per year.
- Students are required to stay in the program for the entire school year.
