Each year, scholarships are awarded to graduating seniors by the Jericho Scholarship Committee and by individuals, local businesses, and organizations. Students have received awards ranging from \$100 to \$1,000.

In order to be considered for **ANY** award, students must complete the appropriate application following this introductory letter and submit to the HS Counseling Center by Friday, February 16, 2024.

The recipients are selected by the HS Scholarship Committee comprised of administration, faculty, and counselors or by the organization sponsoring the scholarship. The scholarships will be presented at Senior Award Night in June.

Merit scholarships are awarded based on specific criteria such as community service, academic excellence, leadership, extracurricular activities, doing ones best or personal growth in overcoming some adversity while in high school. Some scholarships include financial need criteria.
