**ENGLISH 1111 ENGLISH I (Writing Intensive)** 1 semester; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**NOTE:** A grade of "C" or higher is required in ENG 1111 in to be able to take additional CCP English courses.

**ENGLISH 1112 ENGLISH II (Writing Intensive)** 1 semester; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**NOTE:** A grade of "C" or higher is required in ENG 1111 in to be able to take this course.

**ENG 1600 INTRODUCTION TO LITERATURE** 1 semester; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**NOTE:** A grade of A grade of "C" or higher is required in ENG 1111 in order to take this course.

**ENG 2300 GREAT BOOKS: WORLD LITERATURE** 1 semester; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**NOTE:** A grade of A grade of "C" or higher is required in ENG 1111 in order to take this course.

Completion of ENG 1112 or concurrent enrollment in ENG 1112 is **REQUIRED** to take this course.

**MTH 1280 COLLEGE ALGEBRA** full year; 4 college credits; 1 high school credit

**STT 2640 and STT 2650 ELEMENARY STATISTICS I and II**

full year for both courses; 3/2 college credits; 1/0.66 high school credits

**NOTE:** A grade of "C" or higher is required in STT 2640 in order to receive college credit for STT 2650 the second semester.

**MTH 1340 PRE-CALCULUS** full year; 5 college credits; 1 high school credit

**MTH 2200 CALCULUS I** full year; 5 college credits; 1 high school credit

**GLG 1133 ENVIRONMENTAL GEOLOGY** full year; 4 college credits; 1 high school credit

**GEO 1000 INTRO TO GIS & Cartography** 1 semester; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**HST 1220 – AMERICAN HISTORY SINCE 1865** 1 semester; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**NOTE:** Completion of ENG 1111 or concurrent enrollment in ENG 1111 is **STRONGLY** recommended.

**PLS 1100 – INTRO TO AMERICAN POLITICS** 1 semester; 3 semester credits; 1 high school credit

**Note:** Completion of ENG 1111 on concurrent enrollment in ENG 1111 is **REQUIRED** to take this course.

**PSY 1111 INTRO TO PSYCHOLOGY** 1 semester; 3 semester credits; 1 high school credit

**FRN 1112 BEGINNING FRENCH II** full year; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**FRN 2111 INTERMEDIATE FRENCH I** full year; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**FRN 2112 INTERMEDIATE FRENCH II** full year; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**SPN 1112 SPANISH II** full year; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**SPN 2111 SPANISH III** full year; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**SPN 2112 SPANISH IV** full year; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**ITS 1500 HTML & CSS** 1 semester; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**CSE 1100 INTRO TO CYBER SECURITY** 1 semester; 3 college credits; 1 high school credit

**TOTAL COLLEGE COURSES APPROVED BY CLARK STATE TO OFFER AT KENTON RIDGE:**

**24 COURSES** for a total of **77 college semester credits**.

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**Step 1: All students wanting to participate in College Credit Plus for the 2024-25 school year (even if they participated in 2024-25) can meet the information and counseling requirement by attending the Informational Meeting which will be held in January/February every year. There will be two components – general information about CCP and information about CCP at Kenton Ridge. The powerpoints from both components will be available on the KR website after the Informational Meeting is held. One powerpoint is general information about College Credit Plus that applies to all Ohio students; the other is specific to Kenton Ridge.**

**Step 2: Submit the “Intent to Participate” form to the Guidance Office, with parent and student signature, *on or before April 1*. This is a deadline established by the Ohio Department of Education. This form MUST be submitted by the deadline to be eligible to take ANY courses through the CCP program in 2024-25 including summer 2024. NOTE: April 1, 2024 is the Monday we return from Spring Break.**

**Step 3: Be sure to meet the application and testing requirements for the college(s) you plan to attend or earn credit from. All of the CCP courses offered at KR are through Clark State so the Clark State application and testing requirements need to be met for the CCP courses at KR.**
