

CCP TESTING INFORMATION AND SCORE REQUIREMENTS

(subject to change)

NOTE: ENG 1111 IS a prerequisite/co-requisite course in order to take **PLS 1100 Introduction to American Politics**. If you have NOT successfully completed ENG 1111 (grade of "C" or better) and plan to take PLS 1100 next year, you will need to add ENG 1111 to your schedule for next year or plan to take it through Clark State. **ENG 1111 is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** to be taken prior to or concurrently with **HST 1220 American History since 1865**.

FOR STUDENTS TAKING CCP FOR THE FIRST TIME - MEETING THE REQUIREMENT FOR ELIGIBILITY/ADMISSION:

If your cumulative GPA is 3.0 or higher, send me an email requesting that I send your transcript to Clark State so your GPA can be used to meet the eligibility/admission requirement to participate in CCP at Clark State.

If your cumulative GPA is below 3.0 you will need to take the ACCUPLACER test at Clark State. Register for the ACCUPLACER on-line through the Clark State website and give me your scores as soon as you get them. For eligibility/admission, you will need to earn a college ready score on one of the following tests (everyone should take the Reading test).

READING - score of 250 or above (OR ACT Reading score of 22 or above)

MATH - score of 263 or above (OR ACT Math score of 22 or above)

FOR COURSE PLACEMENT - THE FOLLOWING ACT OR ACCUPLACER SCORES ARE NEEDED (you do not have to retest if you have been admitted and meet the following score requirements for the courses you plan to take next year):

READING: score of 240 or higher OR ACT Reading score of 21

NOTE: The Reading testing requirement can be met by having a FINAL grade of "A" or higher in Advanced English. Ask Mrs. Young to send your transcript to Clark State.

MATH: Differs depending on the math course:

MTH 1280-College Algebra: ACT Math score of 22 or higher **AND** ACT Reading score of 20 **OR** ACCUPLACER Advanced Algebra & Functions score of 250 **AND** Reading score of 230.

STT 2640-Statistics: ACT Math score of 22 or higher **AND** ACT reading score of 20 or higher **OR** ACCUPLACER Quantitative Reasoning score of 266 **AND** Reading score of 230.

NOTE: The Math testing requirement FOR STATISTICS ONLY can be met by having a FINAL grade of "B" or higher in Advanced Algebra II. Ask me to send your transcript to Clark State.

MTH 1340-Pre-Calculus: Grade of "C" or "higher in MTH 1280-College Algebra **OR** ACT Math score of 23 above **AND** ACT Reading score of 20 **OR** ACCUPLACER Advanced Algebra & Functions score of 266 **AND** Reading score of 230.

MTH 2200-Calculus I: Grade of "C" or higher in MTH 1340-Pre-Calculus **OR** ACT Math score of 26 or higher **AND** ACT Reading score of 20 **OR** ACCUPLACER Advanced Algebra & Functions score of 281 **AND** Reading score of 230.

5. WAIT PERIOD BETWEEN ACCUPLACER RETESTING

From Clark State: Cost is \$15 for the whole test. You only need to pay once to take all areas again, even if YOU take it in different sittings.

- Students must wait 7 days for an initial retest
- Students must wait 30 days for a second retest
- Students must wait 120 days for a third retest

PLEASE GET YOUR SCORES TO ME AS SOON AS YOU TEST FOR THE FIRST TIME SO I CAN LET YOU KNOW IF YOU NEED TO RETEST. YOU WILL HAVE TO WAIT AT LEAST 7 DAYS BEFORE RETESTING. IF YOU HAVE TO RETEST AGAIN, YOU WILL HAVE TO WAIT 30 DAYS. IF YOU HAVE NOT TESTED FOR THE FIRST TIME YET, YOU WILL NOT HAVE TIME TO RETEST FOR THE THIRD TIME TO BE READY FOR CLASSES FOR NEXT YEAR.

I know this can be complicated so please stop by Guidance or email me with any questions you may have.

Reminder to have all steps completed, including meeting the testing requirement for eligibility and/or course placement by **MAY 31**. If you plan to take courses at Clark State during summer and/or fall term, I will need that schedule by May 31 also. Registration for summer and fall term is available now.
