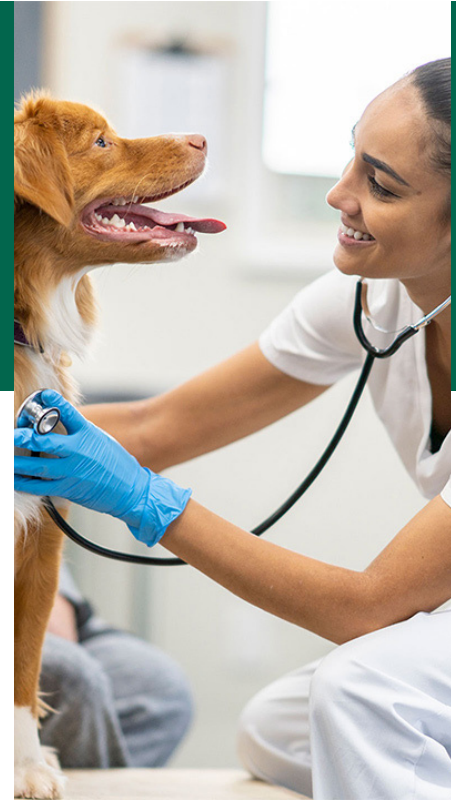




VETERINARY SCIENCE PATHWAY



Program Overview

The Veterinary Science program provides students with an opportunity to investigate the small and large animal veterinary industry through hands-on lab work. Students will learn: animal care, common office practices, medical terminology, laboratory procedures, animal diseases, animal anatomy and physiology and animal genetics.

Recommended Qualifications

- Students can enroll in Veterinary Science as a junior or senior.
- GPA of a 2.5 or higher is recommended.
- Interview process may be required.
- A genuine interest in the vet science career field.
- Enjoy lab work and dissections.
- Enjoy working with and around animals.
- Good communication and social skills.
- Must be able to handle a very structured. environment, (rules, policies, procedures)
- Basic Math, Literacy, Science foundational skills.
- Ability to handle quick-paced, high-pressure situations in a high-risk environment that is often loud.
- Ability to work independently after the given direction.
- Physical activity involved.
- No discipline referrals or out of school suspensions.
- No more than ten absences per year.
- Students are required to stay in the program for the entire school year.
