Cambridge and AVID encourages learner centered and inquiry-based approaches to learning and develops learners' skills in creative thinking, inquiry and problem solving, giving learners' excellent preparation for the next stage in their education. Standards-based grading, an educational system that provides students with a clearer picture of their progress and mastery because they can see which specific skills they've mastered and where they might need more practice, is utilized in the majority of courses at SLHS.

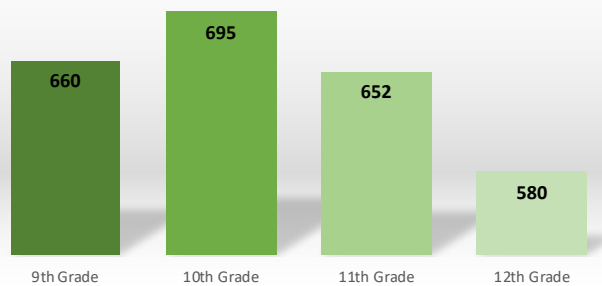

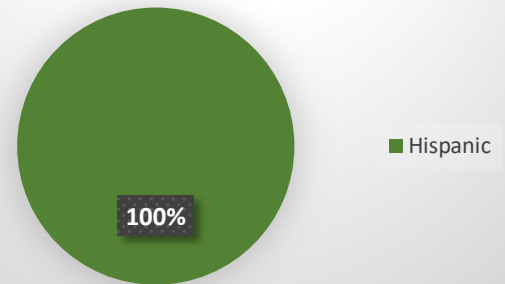

DATA SNAPSHOT OF THE CLASS OF 2022

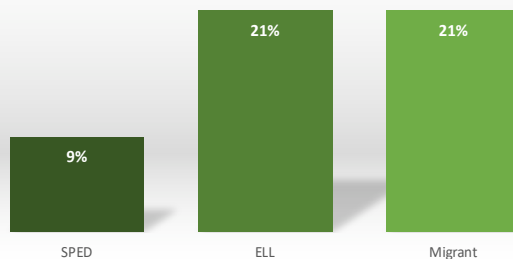
Student Population by Grade Level



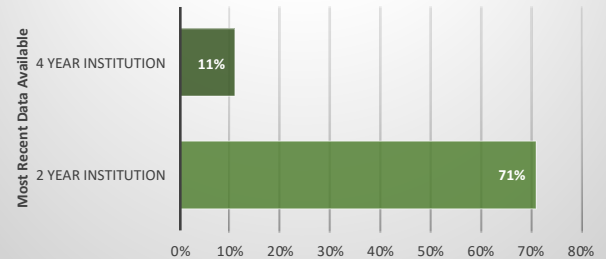
Race and Ethnicity
