CAMP POLICIES

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If your plans change and you need to cancel your registration prior to April 15, 2024, you will receive a full refund, except for the deposit per camp. If cancellation occurs between April 16, 2024 and May 15, 2024, 50% of the camp is non-refundable. Payment is due in full on May 15, 2024. No refunds will be issued in the event of withdrawal from any summer program after May 16, 2024, to ensure staffing and programmatic commitments to all families. Cancellations must be given in writing to the Summer Camp Program Directors.

No refunds will be given due to student absences. No refunds will be given for lost days due to unforeseen acts of nature or environment. In the event New City School is unable to operate (e.g., loss of electricity, fire or other disaster), New City Summer participants will be notified via email.

SCHEDULE: There will be no camp July 1-5. Early Care, provided free of charge, begins at 7:00 am. Extended Day care after the camp day will be offered until 6:00pm (see below for rates).

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

REGISTRATION: Register for camps using our CampBrain registration system, accessible by visiting **newcitysummercamp.org**

PAYMENT: All payments for New City School Summer Camp will be made by e-check or credit card through our online registration system.

- A non-refundable and non-transferable deposit is due at the time of registration. Deposits are \$50 per week; \$100 for 2-week sessions; \$150 for 3-week sessions.
- Campers may not begin summer camp sessions unless full payment is completed by May 15th.

FINANCIAL AID: If you will be a New City student for the 2024-2025 school year and receive Variable tuition, that will be applied to Summer Camp also. Variable tuition does not automatically apply once you register. When it is applied to your CampBrain account, you will receive an email.

EXTENDED DAY

Extended Day care will be offered after camp dismissal until 6:00pm at a rate of \$100 per week.

Children enrolled in an <u>entire session</u> of Camp Chameleon, Adventure Camp, Explorers Camp, and/ or Young Actors' Theater Camp (YATC) can sign up for Extended Day at the following bulk rates:

• SESSION I (JUN 10 - 28): \$225 for Extended Day all three (3) weeks

• **SESSION II (JUL 8 - 19):** \$150 for Extended Day both weeks

SESSION III (JUL 22 - AUG 9): \$225 for Extended Day all three (3) weeks
YATC (JUN 10 - 28): \$225 for Extended Day all three (3) weeks

Bulk rates do not apply unless campers are enrolled for the full camp session (ex. a camper only attending one (1) week of Session I and one (1) week of Session II would be charged the regular rate of \$100/week, for a total of \$200).

9:00AM-3:30PM




