

CTE Student Enrollment

94,492 total CTE enrollments (**87,383** individual CTE students)

653 CTE programs across **21** community and technical colleges and the Dept. of Corrections

There were **18,222** postsecondary CTE certificates and associate degrees awarded in the 2021/2022 academic year.

14,885 certificates

3,337 associate degrees an individual's credential completion is only counted once even if they ared a certificate and degree during the same academic year

Outcomes

98% continued postsecondary education or training, enlisted in the military or were working within a year following credential completion. — Of these students, —

21% are in an apprenticeship
2% are in the military
