a) *Committee Positions for new school year coming up:*

b) *Science Wing Garden* – Our City Forest has surveyed the area and we'll be receiving 2 trees thru a Microsoft grant

- a. The district has given approval for us to plant a couple of trees in the wing;
- b. Currently looks like the plantings will happen on Feb. 14<sup>th</sup> and it will be during school hours; will look for student helpers
- c) *Goodwill Drive: April 27 (9am - 2pm)*
  - c. We will have a SignUp Genius volunteer sheet for those who'd like to help with offloading donations from cars and sorting.
  - d. Leadership (33 kids) and NJHS (60+ kids) are welcome to join in helping and maybe ask the local boy scout troops for help as well
  - e. Have a flyer to advertise the event and have specific and accurate info about what kinds of donations are allowed and not allowed
- d) *San Jose Giants Baseball Fundraiser - May 4th.* Tickets will be \$18 per ticket plus \$3 service fee. We will have 100 tickets for sale. If we sold all 100, Price earns back \$540. If we need more tickets, more can be added. Might be able to have the mascot come to campus at the Fun Fest to kick it off

## 5) Treasurers Update – Raul

- After the last Giving Campaign deposit of \$18K, we have \$99,343 in our account, but know that we will also have future expenses and that we've gone over in a few areas this year too
- Need to consider adding to the budget for Assemblies next year
- Erika is going to go back and review the GC numbers since something doesn't seem right; and Lara will update the website with the latest fundraising totals
