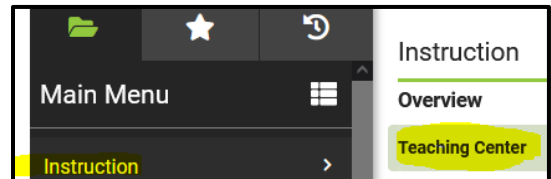

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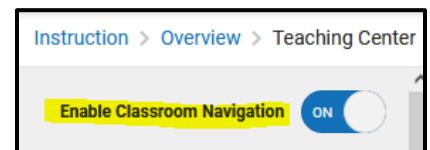

#### ❑ **Campus Instruction > Control Center Renamed:**

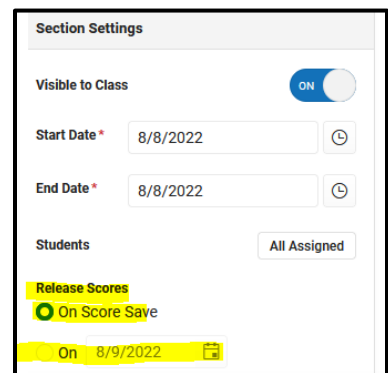
Control Center renamed to **Teaching Center**



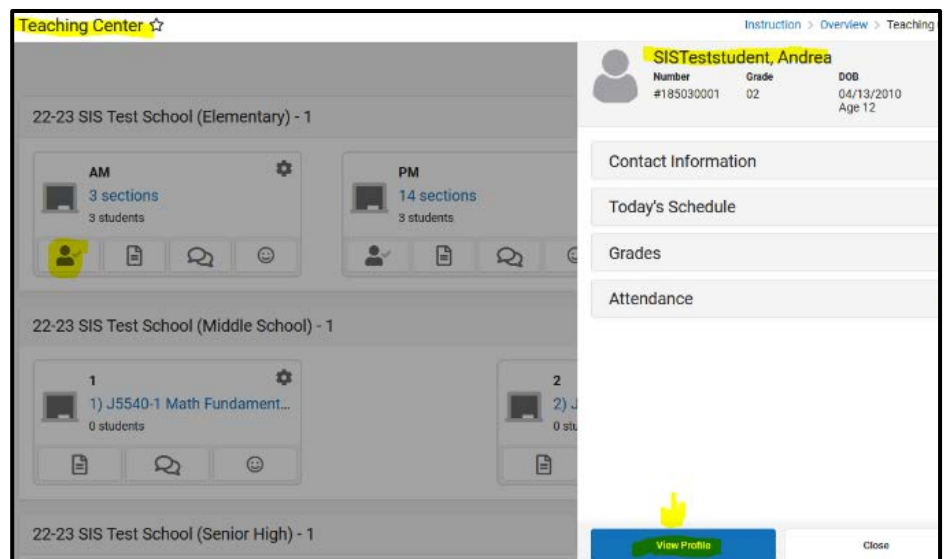
- #### ❑ **New Classroom view:** Section based paradigm for teachers. This view is section based and is just a different view for teacher preference. Give it a try and see which you like.



- #### ❑ **Assignment > Release Scores option:** New option added to Assignments that allows teachers to schedule when scores are released to students and parents on the portal.



- #### ❑ **Student Profile:** Can now be viewed by teachers anywhere the blue student name links displays in the different tools accessed through the Teaching Center. Profile includes contact information, schedule, grades, attendance, in-progress grades and a To-Do List.



- ❑ **Progress Monitor:** now displays assignments aligned to grading tasks (not just Standards).
  - View grades for all students or use the eye icon to see just one student at a time (great for conferences).
  - Filter to see all scores or just Released Scores
  - Other filters in the bottom of the screen to see different groups in one
  - Add new assignments from here
  - Click the 3 dots next to the Blue Grade then Score Analysis to see a scale of how students are doing. Click on the different sections of the scale to see which students fall in the different zones.
  - And so much more....

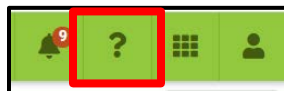

## --- Teacher Tips ---

- ❑ Use keyboard shortcut Cntrl +/- to change the size of Campus Instruction.
- ❑ Remove Index to show more of the grade book, click the triple lines icon next to the Message Center.
- ❑ Use categories so it is easy to identify at a quick glance where students are struggling (i.e. tests, homework, projects, class participation).
- ❑ Items that are blue and underlined are linked to the related details, for example, in the roster, click on student name and it brings up their relationship and demographic data.
- ❑ Seating Charts for skinned course/sections can all be on one seating chart. Just scroll to the bottom of the Seating Chart > New > Sections > and you will see options for your sections that are skinned to be selected as the option for the seating chart.
- ❑ Seating Chart: want to switch two students, just drag and drop one on top of the other and it automatically just switches which student is in each seat.
- ❑ Can copy seating chart layout once one is made. Once it is set and you want the same layout for the other sections, just click "Copy Layout" in the chart you want copied and walk through the steps from the new section.
- ❑ For Student Submissions (electronic) have the students add their name to the file name when uploading so you can compare if the name on the upload is the same as the creator of the file, also it makes it easy to identify whose assignments are whose.
- ❑ Keep in mind that the Portal for Students and Parents is a "BEFORE" tool, not an after tool. Set up assignments so parents/students can use it to plan and prepare...no excuses.
- ❑ For use with Parents:
  - Use last login (in the Grade Book, click on the students name to expand and look at the date next to Login:, that is the last time a parent logged into Portal) to introduce or ask why they are not utilizing it.
  - Pictures say a lot for some parents so utilize Sparkline or Box and Whiskers but leave it simple such as "This is the top score, this is the bottom score, the dot is your student".
  - Sparkline graph is ALWAYS in date order so when looking at the Sparkline graph, sort assignments by date also so they correspond.
  - Get many phone calls/emails/questions that an assignment is past due but no grade is entered because you just haven't had the chance to enter them, use the "Turned In" flag to let parents/students know you have it just haven't entered the grade or the new release scores.
