	<p>STEM:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sink and Float Experiment - Find 6 small objects in your home that can be put in water. • Predict/guess which will float or sink. • Test your objects by putting them into a container of water.
	<p>Physical Education: Dance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Put on your favorite song or turn on the radio. Dance however you like during the entire song!
