How do we decide who gets a support class?



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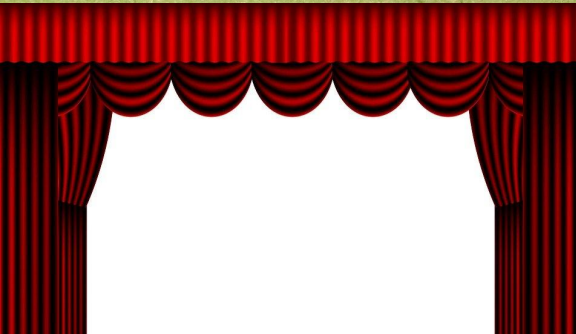

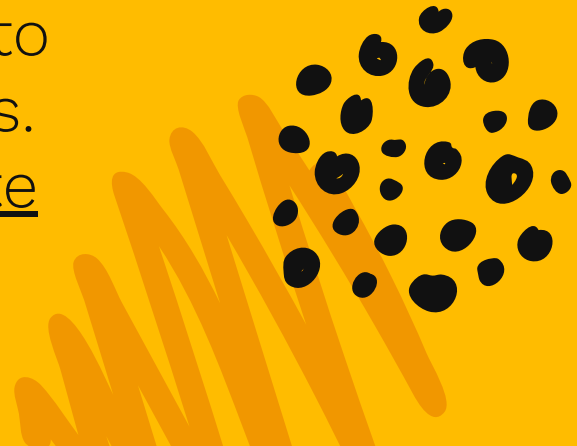
