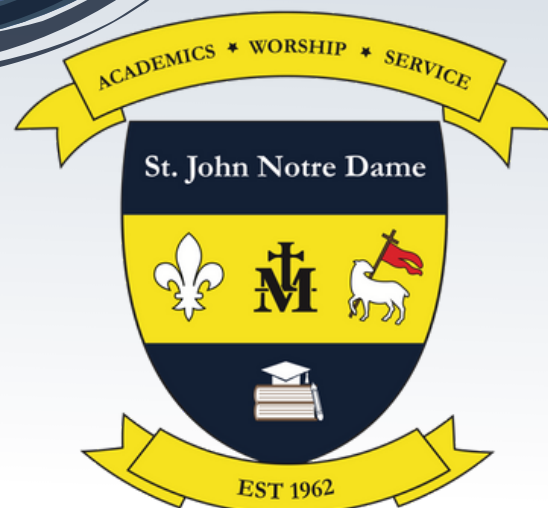

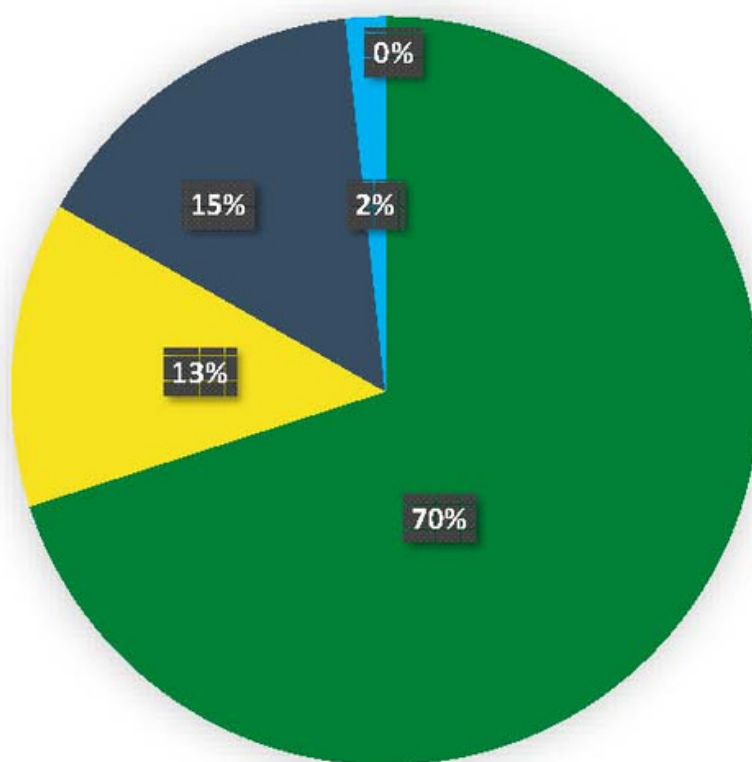

THE COST TO EDUCATE THE CHILD

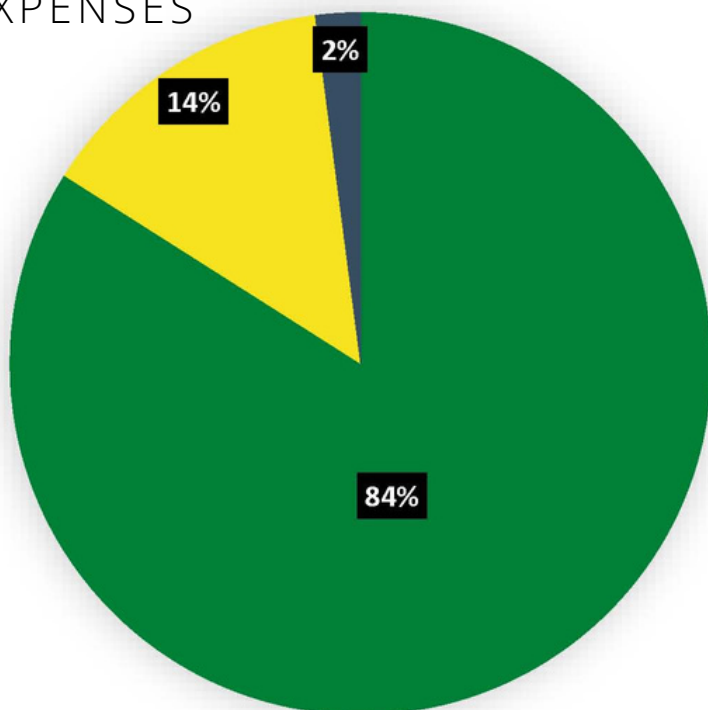
While we realize tuition makes up the majority of our revenue, the school receives additional funds through fundraising and tuition assistance, which is used to educate our students. For the 2021-22 school year the actual cost to educate the child was \$8,443 ; while our tuition rate for one Catholic student was \$6,460. If you consider the tuition that is paid for one student, you will see that each student received a discount of \$1,943 due to fundraising.

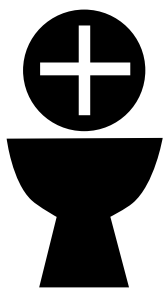
