



THE COST TO EDUCATE THE CHILD

While we realize tuition makes up the majority of our revenue, the school receives additional funds through fundraising and tuition assistance, which is used to educate our students. For the 2021-22 school year the actual cost to educate the child was \$8,443; while our tuition rate for one Catholic student was \$6,460. If you consider the tuition that is paid for one student, you will see that each student received a discount of \$1,943 due to fundraising.









Once again, we would like to thank all of our families and community members who helped in any way with our fundraisers last year. Whether you chaired or attended an event, bought raffle tickets, donated time or money, we are grateful for your contribution. The success of our fundraising directly affects our tuition rates and we appreciate any and all support.
