Saint Constantine College believes that the first year to second year retention rate of first-time, full-time freshmen is one of the indicators of undergraduate students' successful adjustment to college life. We also track the fall-to-spring retention rate as a predictor of the fall-to-fall retention rate. Saint Constantine College strives to have a high retention rate that stems from our commitment to excellence in the admissions process.

Graduation Rate

The undergraduate graduation rate represents the percentage of students who successfully complete their educational goals and do so in an expected timeframe. This rate is reported as both a four-year graduation rate and a six-year graduation rate. The undergraduate graduation rate is one of the outcomes that Saint Constantine College tracks, along with the rates of students who are still enrolled or have transferred to another institution. Saint Constantine College aims to have a higher-than-average graduation rate due to our commitment to excellence in education.

Saint Constantine College was recognized in August 2021 by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board as an institution with the authority to grant degrees. The first cohort of students who transferred into our BA program in Fall 2021 is expected to graduate in Spring 2024. The four-year undergraduate graduation rate for that cohort will be available in June 2024.
