- Candidate Criteria
 - The successful candidate for the Boyle County Schools superintendent should be an innovative leader, committed to maintaining a culture of academic excellence
 - The successful candidate will be responsible for executing the strategic vision of the Board of Education by creating, developing and guiding a challenging, rigorous learning environment for all stakeholders
 - The ideal candidate will be a strong leader who believes in innovation and positive risk-taking, and one who is equipped to implement strategies and remove barriers to learning while overseeing the day to day operations of the district
 - The successful candidate must have administrative experience to elevate growth in student achievement levels as well as the arts and athletics
 - Maintain strong relationships with all stakeholders in the school district and communities served, while leading with strong moral character and integrity
 - Knowledge and experience in school budgeting, finance and operations, along with knowledge of the Kentucky Education System are required
