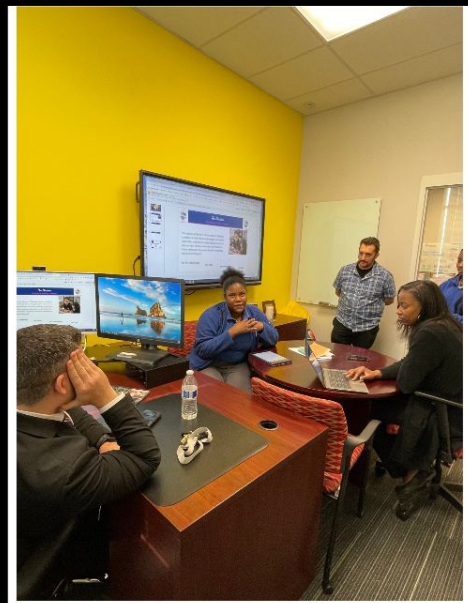


# The Intersection of Classroom Learning and the Practical Realities of Bureaucracy
