*I understand that Summer Camp starts June 5 and ends Aug 4th. *Each family is allowed 1 week vacation tuition free. Camp Tuition is \$125 /week per child. (Weekly fee sibling discount: 10% for 2 siblings, 15% discount for 3 siblings.)* I agree to pay tuition for all other weeks of camp, even if my child is absent. *Additionally, there is a one-time Field Trip Fee of \$85/student due when turning in the enrollment forms to secure a child's placement.*

Little Bronchos Discipline/Guidance Policy: Discipline Policy/

Camp Classroom Management:

It is very important a child's development is nurtured through caring, patience and understanding. While caring for your child, Little Bronchos staff may have to respond to your child's misbehavior. Hitting, kicking, spitting, hostile verbal behavior and other behaviors which will hurt another child are not permitted.

In response to these behaviors, Little Bronchos staff will not use:

- Threats, bribes, or physical punishment, even if requested by parent
- Depriving your child of food or other basic needs
- Humiliation or isolation

In response to misbehavior, Little Bronchos staff will:

- Respect your child
- Establish clear rules and be consistent in enforcing rules
- Use positive language to explain desired behaviors and speak calmly while bending down to children's eye level
- Give clear choices and redirect child to a new activity as needed
- Move child to a time-out chair for no longer than one minute per year of child's age, if necessary.

If a child's behavior is very disruptive or harmful to himself or other children, Little Bronchos staff will discuss the issue with the family privately. If the situation can be resolved, the child may remain enrolled. If Little Bronchos staff and family are unable to resolve the issue, the family may be asked to un-enroll from camp. Families may have concerns or wish to offer suggestions. Please feel free to contact Little Bronchos Coordinator at littlebronchos@lsc.k12.in.us to discuss behavior plans for your child.
