CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Peterson called the meeting to order at 4:31 p.m. and noted the presence of the four Trust Board members, constituting a quorum.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Ms. Wilson motioned to approve the agenda as presented; Ms. Bolognini seconded; upon a call to vote, the motion carried with four votes in favor from Mrs. Wong, Ms. Wilson, Ms. Bolognini and Mr. Peterson.

BOARD AND STAFF INTRODUCTIONS

Mr. Peterson welcomed everyone in attendance.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Mr. Peterson read the call to the public.

Approval of Minutes

Ms. Bolognini motioned to approve the October 21, 2020 minutes; Ms. Wilson seconded; upon a call to vote, the motion carried with four votes in favor from Mr. Peterson, Ms. Bolognini, Mrs. Wong, and Ms. Wilson.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Assistant Superintendent's Update

Mr. Barragan announced that our current Risk Manager, Joanna Morse, has resigned and he expressed it was a "great loss" to GESD. He is currently working on the process to find her replacement.

Mr. Barragan stated the possibility of having a financial statement of the VSIG COVID-19 Pre-Paid Legal Defense Program for the next Trust Board meeting.

Mr. Barragan mentioned the Parental Acknowledgement forms are being monitored and GESD has currently received about 2,500.

Mr. Barragan commented on the declining enrollment presentation to the Governing Board last Thursday, December 10^{th} . Enrollment is less than the 95-96 school year with 13 sites open in comparison to the 20-21 school year with 17 sites.

Mr. Barragan shared information on proposition 208 and the impact to the schools; funds are expected to come in the 22-23 school year.

Mr. Barragan informed the Healthcare performance presentation will be postponed, but a bullet point summary will be provided.

Mr. Barragan gave an update on the Capital Lawsuit.

Mr. Barragan communicated GESD has been assigned a new Valley Schools account manager, Elvis Becerra.

Claims Experience Review - Medical

Mr. Barragan reported:

In October, GESD incurred \$721,183 in medical claims, which represents a monthly loss ratio of 101%.

There are two (2) claims above \$75,000 and one (1) is above the \$200,000 stop loss level totaling \$404,810. This represents 18% of the total medical claims. The anticipated refund is \$123,175 for the claim(s) exceeding the stop loss level.

Based on the trend, we project revenues to generate \$8,086,236 by June 30, 2021 and we anticipate to incur medical claims of approximately \$6,768,372, or a loss ratio of 84% by June 30, 2021.

In September, GESD incurred \$521,769 in medical claims, which represents a monthly loss ratio of 73%.

Claims Experience Review - Dental

Mr. Barragan reported:

In October, Pool I (or base plan) incurred \$47,931 in dental claims or a monthly loss ratio of 35%.

Based on the trend, we project revenues to generate \$1,622,928 by June 30, 2021 and we anticipate Pool I (or base plan) to incur approximately \$1,075,470, or a loss ratio of 66% by June 30, 2021.

In October, Pool III (or buy-up plan) incurred \$214,514 in dental claims or a monthly loss ratio of 63%.

Based on the trend, we project revenues to generate \$4,011,000 by June 30, 2021 and we anticipate Pool III (or base plan) to incur approximately \$3,247,152, or a loss ratio of 81% by June 30, 2021.

<u>Financial Review - Employee Benefits</u>

Mr. Barragan presented:

The financial report for October 31, 2020 reflects the "Ending net position reserved for claims and expenses" as \$23,752,321.82.

Claims Experience Review - Workers' Compensation

Mr. Barragan reported:

In November, GESD logged eleven (11) incidents and GESD incurred \$3,200 for the month.

GESD has 29 open claims recorded since 2013 and the "Paid" amount is \$2,610,321.31 compared to the "Incurred" of \$3,337,361.16.

GESD has six (6) claimants above \$75,000 (based on the "Paid" amount) and three (3) above \$150,000. For the purpose of workers' compensation, the stop-loss-level is \$350,000.

The "Paid" amount for the six (6) claimants are \$2,404,490.67 or 92% of the total "Paid" amount of \$2,610,321.31 and \$2,932,641.44 or 88% of the total "Incurred" amount of \$3,337,361.16.

The average cost per individuals is:

- \$90,011.08 for "Paid"
- \$115,081.42 for "Incurred"

In October, GESD logged eleven (11) incidents and GESD incurred \$9,150 for the month.

GESD has 28 open claims recorded since 2013 and the "Paid" amount is \$2,599,162.95 compared to the "Incurred" of \$3,333,799.07.

GESD has six (6) claimants above \$75,000 (based on the "Paid" amount) and three (3) above \$150,000. For the purpose of workers' compensation, the stop-loss-level is \$350,000.

The "Paid" amount for the six (6) claimants are \$2,401,293.77 or 92% of the total "Paid" amount of \$2,599,162.95 and \$2,932,641.44 or 88% of the total "Incurred" amount of \$3,333,799.07.

The average cost per individuals is:

- \$92,827.25 for "Paid"
- \$119,064.25 for "Incurred"

Mr. Lee questioned injuries occurring at home while on the job and what a recommended successful work at home environment would be.

Financial Review - Worker's Compensation

Mr. Barragan reported:

The financial report for October 31, 2020 reflects the "Ending net position reserved for claims and expenses" as \$2,563,543.27.

Wellness and Insurance Benefit Update

Mrs. Wong stated preventative care/wellness visits have decreased.

Mrs. Wong shared about HR's initiatives that promote mental health.

Mrs. Wong shared UnitedHealthcare is now offering parting employees health insurance marketplace coverage to compare in addition to COBRA.

Mrs. Wong announced Walgreens flu shot vouchers are now available for non-benefited employees.

Mrs. Wong commented that six (6) sites have participated in the financial literacy presentations and each site has had a higher number of participants in comparison to last year.

Summary of Current Events

Trust Board members congratulated Ms. Wilson for her re-election to the Governing Board.

Ms. Bolognini mentioned the GB meeting addressing boundaries, school closures and/or repurposing of schools. Ms. Bolognini complimented the Superintendents leadership.

Ms. Bolognini motioned to adjourn, Ms. Wilson seconded; upon a call to vote, the motion carried with four votes in favor from Mr. Peterson, Ms. Wilson, Mrs. Wong, and Ms. Bolognini.

In November, GESD incurred \$650,970 in medical claims, which represents a monthly loss ratio of 92%.

There are three (3) claims above \$75,000 and one (1) is above \$200,000 stop loss level totaling \$601,765. This represents 21% of the total medical claims. The anticipated refund is \$125,593 for the claim(s) exceeding the stop loss level.

Based on the trend, we project revenues to generate \$8,180,400 by June 30, 2021 and we anticipate to incur medical claims of approximately \$6,977,532 or a loss ratio of 85% by June 30, 2021.

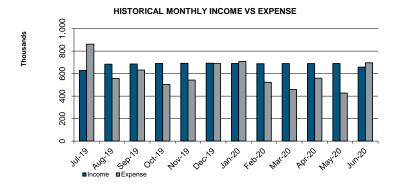

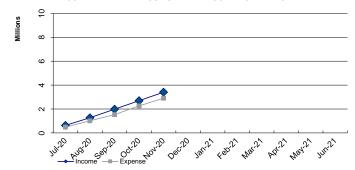

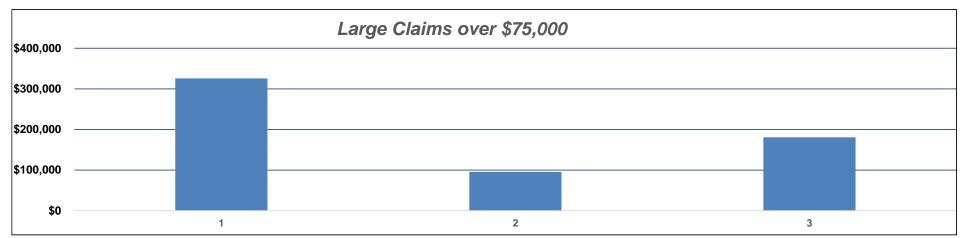

In November, Pool I (or base plan) incurred \$96,291 in dental claims or a monthly loss ratio of 70%.

Based on the trend, we project revenues to generate \$1,626,312 by June 30, 2021 and we anticipate Pool I (or base plan) to incur approximately \$1,188,576 or a loss ratio of 73% by June 30, 2021.

In October, Pool III (or buy-up plan) incurred \$220,955 in dental claims or a monthly loss ratio of 65%.

Based on the trend, we project revenues to generate \$4,018,992 by June 30, 2021 and we anticipate Pool III (or base plan) to incur approximately \$3,128,004 or a loss ratio of 78% by June 30, 2021.

In December, GESD logged two (2) incidents and GESD incurred \$3,350 for the month.

GESD has 20 open claims recorded since 2013 and the "Paid" amount is \$2,624,706.88 compared to the "Incurred" of \$3,300,353.63.

GESD has six (6) claimants above \$75,000 (based on the "Paid" amount) and four (4) above \$150,000. For the purpose of workers' compensation, the stop-loss-level is \$350,000.

The "Paid" amount for the six (6) claimants are \$2,434,892.15 or 93% of the total "Paid" amount of \$2,624,706.88 and \$\$2,932,641.44 or 89% of the total "Incurred" amount of \$3,300,353.63.
