Richfield Heritage Preserve invites all K - 6 students in public, private, or home school groups to enter the 2nd Annual RHP Youth Art Contest.

Art should depict a native plant, animal, or natural landscape found in Ohio.
Any art medium can be used!

All entries must be on paper for display purposes. Entries must be no smaller than 4x6 inches and no larger than 18x24 inches.

Entry fee: \$5. Cash or check may be dropped off at the Park Office with your entry.

Entry form must be completed and taped or attached to the back of the artwork- please do not put your name on the front of your entry.

One entry per student will be accepted. - Entries will not be mailed back to you.
You may collect your artwork at the Park Office during regular business hours beginning **Monday, March 11, 2024**, or by calling 330-888-0511.

Judging:

Judges will rate entries based on creativity, originality, quality of the artwork, and artistic skill demonstrated. Every entry will receive a printed participation certificate. Prizes will be awarded to the top entries in K-3 and 4-6 grade levels.

Art will be displayed in The Lodge on Sunday, **March 10, 2024, from 2-4 pm.**
