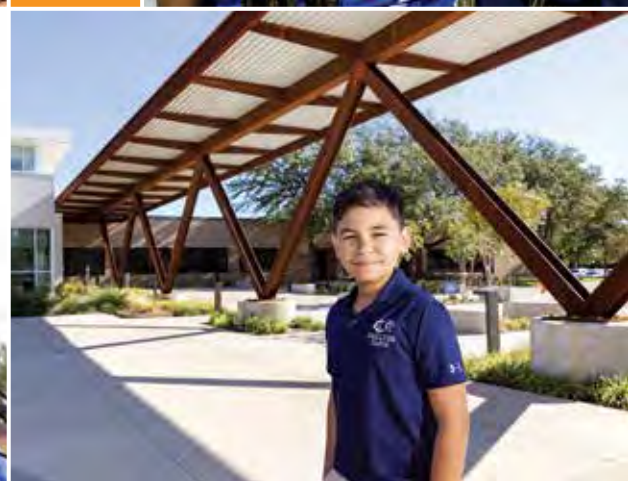

# FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Thank you to our wonderful families, staff, board members, alumni and friends who do so much to support our mission and student experience. Our mission has never wavered. Shelton is the largest independent school worldwide for intelligent students with learning differences. No other school holds such expertise, experience, services and reputation under one roof. At Shelton, we want our students to know that to be diagnosed with a learning difference, you have to be intelligent. When students come to a school with teachers who understand that our students process information in a different way, it opens up a whole new learning experience for them. Before coming to Shelton, many of our students were quiet, didn't take risks and were not involved in extracurriculars. But the power of feeling seen and accepted when they come to our school is incredible. Our goal is for our students to embrace and understand their learning differences.

I am grateful for the teachers, staff, students, families and board members who make up our Shelton community. We welcomed 247 new families in 2021-2022 and ended the year with 1,078 students. Our Parents' Association is like no other. We appreciate the 2021-2022 Shelton Parents' Association, led by Co-Presidents **Emily Sarche** and **Brandy Wayne**. Thanks to the leadership of Auction Co-Chairs **Mandy Evans** and **Kimber Hartmann** and a team of volunteers, a record \$1,035,000 was raised at the Stampede Auction April 1. The SPA leaders presented a check for \$885,000 at the SPA End of the Year Luncheon May 5. Our staff was given more than \$100,000 in the Holiday Happiness fund. We appreciate the parents who are working to make the 2022-2023 school year successful, including SPA Co-Presidents **JoAnna Sudbeck** and **Gina Rangel Pena**.

Thank you to those of you who contributed to our 2021-2022 Annual Fund. Our goal was \$950,000 and we surpassed that and received \$1.3 million in gifts. We appreciate Annual Fund Co-Chairs **Michelle Rivera** and **Chuck Marlett** and Director of Development **Theresa Bruno**. We are grateful to Michelle and Chuck for serving as the 2022-2023 co-chairs.

## Student Accomplishments

Students are overcoming the odds and accomplishing great things at Shelton! Our 68 graduates in the Class of 2022 received 258 acceptances to 109 colleges and \$5,684,176 in merit scholarships. The seniors contributed 1,879.25 hours in community service. Among the class were:

- 27 National Honor Society members
- one student who earned a perfect ACT score on the reading and science sections (**Thomas Owens**)
- one National Merit Commended Scholar (**Mackenzie Dupré**)
- one SMU Hunt Leadership Scholar (**Keaton Cheves**)
- four athletes who signed to play four college sports:
  - **Peyton Frady**, Hendrix College, softball
  - **Brice Weinstein**, Austin College, football
  - **Charlie Leake**, Centenary College, baseball
  - **Drew Stuckey**, Southwestern University, track and field

Valedictorian **Mackenzie Dupré**, who attends Trinity University, spoke at our graduation about how grateful she is to have been a part of a community where she and others belonged and felt loved for who they are. Class of 2022 Salutatorian **Ava Aidala**, who attends the University of Texas at Austin and is majoring in Sustainability Studies, said in the graduation program that Shelton equipped her with the tools she needs to be successful and taught her how to seek out the support necessary to achieve her goals.

## Programs and Activities

We're always trying to add programs, clubs and opportunities so that our students have something that they look forward to in addition to our academics.

Shelton's Words & Music program was developed when Speech-Language Pathologist **Lauren Magee** introduced Shelton to the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum's Words & Music initiative. In this program, students practice creative writing and improve their skills through songwriting. Students in Middle School English classes wrote their own lyrics utilizing the framework they learned during the 10-lesson curriculum. Some of the songs were selected and recorded by professional songwriters from the Country Music Hall of Fame. We can't wait to hear the songs written by students in this year's program!

Shelton's new Esports team plays Rocket League (car soccer) against other TAPPS schools. Two teams of three students practice each week on Tuesdays with competitions taking place every Thursday. The coaches are **Corey Smith** and **Kyle Belz**. Thanks to our Shelton Parents' Association for making the Esports team possible.

Shelton's Drumline and Band had the opportunity to play at the YTexas Summit at AT&T Stadium on Sept. 30. The YTexas Summit is the largest business symposium in the state and featured networking, exhibitors, panel discussions and more. Shelton was a sponsor of the event, thanks to Shelton parent **Laurie Sprouse**.

## Security Upgrades

We are grateful to the **Moody Foundation** for providing a grant to upgrade Shelton's security features. The funding allows us to install outside speakers for emergencies, add security window shades to classrooms and offices and implement the Raptor school security system to improve our emergency response procedures. In addition, we installed a security booth and are adding an electronic gate at our Summerside entrance to limit access to the campus during the school day.

## Design Improvements

Our students continue to love our campus. It's so much fun to have facilities that match the passion of our children and their intelligence. We have been working on some exciting design improvements inside the building. Color has been added to help guide our students around the building and murals grace the walls in addition to some other inspiring features. I would like to thank the **Aphrodite** and **Sam Paulos** family for their time, generosity and commitment to the entire design project. Aphrodite spent hours on the design project. **Jennifer Dix** served on the design team as well and has provided valuable input. I'm also grateful to teacher **Kathleen Goree** for heading up the project and to **Melinda Bracy** with the Bracy Design Team for her professional expertise.

Art depicting 51 faces of successful people with learning differences who have achieved greatness in their fields is featured on the wall near our interior entrance. The art by **Reuben Cheatem** was commissioned by the generosity of the **Aschaffenburg family**.

The "Shelton Tree Mural: Growing the Seeds of Success One Student at a Time" was designed by the collaborative efforts of students **Ford Meyers** and **River Evans**, teacher **Courtney Dios** and design firm **Kendall Creative**. It was made possible by the generosity of the **Garnett** and **Michael Holmes** family in honor of their children, Taylor, Andrew and Parker.

"Hands That Empower" is an illustration that shows how the Shelton community works together to create a culture that lifts each other up by providing learning, confidence, trust, friendship and support. Contributing students included **Hunter Padgett**, **Sarah Solomons**, **Avery Eckert** and **Molly Morris**.

## Patrons' Party

We were thrilled to host a Patrons' Party at Shelton on Nov. 2 to thank everyone who helped us get to the new campus. Our student speaker was **Keaton Cheves**, who graduated from Shelton in 2022 and is a freshman at SMU, where he received the prestigious Hunt Leadership Scholarship, is a member of the SMU football team and serves on the campus services advisory panel. He spoke about how he took advantage of every opportunity to get involved in a variety of activities at Shelton, including tennis, baseball, basketball, football and soccer. During his senior year, he was Student Council president, captain of the football team and the face of Shelton's Charger Daily News.

"I began to believe in myself because my teachers believed in me," Keaton told the audience. "I learned it's okay to learn differently. I felt welcome, comfortable and safe. I was able

to take risks and succeed. I developed a confidence in myself at Shelton that I had lost. I am grateful to Shelton and its teachers."

## Shelton's Resources

In addition to the Shelton Evaluation Center and the Outreach/Teacher Training Department, we offer the following therapy resources available on Shelton's campus during the school day.

- The Shelton Speech, Language & Hearing Center provides speech/language evaluations and private speech therapy to Shelton students and children in other schools throughout DFW to improve communication difficulties including articulation, language, fluency and high-level language skills/reading comprehension. The center also works with many students to improve social language and social cognition, both privately and in groups.
- **Dr. Susan Istre** and her team of expert child and family therapists at the Center for Social Success provide private counseling services to help children with learning differences. Students can receive counseling services during the school day to address common issues regarding anxiety, low frustration tolerance, friendships, self-esteem, family life challenges and a variety of other concerns.
- **Rusty Lozano's** "Coping Skills Training for Kids" program utilizes a broad array of therapy approaches such as animal-assisted therapy, counseling and biofeedback-assisted relaxation and focus training to teach children healthy ways to cope with stress, anxiety and anger.
- Integrative Pediatric Therapy was founded by **Sally Fryer Dietz**, PT, SIPT Cert, CST-D. IPT's degreed and licensed physical therapists and occupational therapists incorporate sensory integration techniques to accelerate and enhance treatment goals and developmental progress.

Thank you for your ongoing support, encouragement and partnership. Know that we will continue to work together to demonstrate the individual and collective strength, resilience and character that define Shelton.

# SPEECH/LANGUAGE/HEARING CENTER NEWS

The mission of the Speech, Language & Hearing Center has long been to serve students and families, at Shelton and in the community alike, by providing thorough and informative screens, comprehensive speech and language evaluations, and, of course, speech therapy services of the highest quality. We could never begin to fulfill this mission without our team of experienced and caring clinicians. Our greatest goal is to help our clients realize success by giving them the tools to better communicate.

## Speech Center Community Screening Program

A speech and language screening allows a speech pathologist the opportunity to observe the way a child comprehends and uses language and articulates sounds, relates to others with social language and develops pre-reading skills. Fluency of speech and quality of voice is also evaluated. A screening determines a student's risk for reading and language difficulty and the need for evaluation and/or intervention.

Why should a child's speech, language and reading be screened? Children use language comprehension and oral language skills to learn about their world, develop school readiness skills and relate to peers. As early as preschool and kindergarten, we expect children to begin to follow routines, communicate their wants and needs effectively, learn and remember concepts and begin to practice pre-literacy skills and social language. A screening is designed to tap into possible weaknesses in these areas that may contribute to difficulty with communication or learning to read. Early intervention is critical not only for closing language learning gaps and providing a stable foundation upon which to build future language, but also for avoiding frustration and allowing a child to maintain self-esteem and confidence in his or her ability to communicate.

The Speech, Language, Reading, Hearing and Vision screening program is a key component to the mission of the Shelton Speech Center. A team of licensed and experienced speech-language pathologists begins screenings each school year the last week of August. This team of qualified professionals travels to a different school in the Dallas area each week for the next 10 weeks. By the time November rolls around, therapists have provided screenings for about 2,000 children.

This year therapists packed their bags and headed to Fort Worth for screenings with our newest partnership, Fort Worth Country Day. FWCD is home to 1,100 students, 220 faculty and staff and sits on a sprawling 104-acre campus. **Teresa Hoppe**, Lower School Learning Specialist, says, "We are very glad that we have partnered with Shelton to provide screenings for our students at FWCD. The information is invaluable as we strive to support our students in the best way possible. Moving forward, the annual Shelton screenings will help us track student progress and provide incredibly useful information for our families and faculty."

# OUTREACH OFFERINGS

Christine Bedenbaugh, M.ED., LDT, CALT, QI Director of Shelton Outreach Training



This past year, we continued training teachers utilizing a synchronous training model via Zoom, in person in Shelton's training lab or onsite at the client's school. Offering training live via Zoom has allowed us to provide opportunities to adult learners who would otherwise not have access to our training due to proximity or logistics.

Shelton offers three accredited teacher training courses for educators serving students with dyslexia at both the Associate/Teaching and Therapy Levels.

- 1) Shelton Academic Language Approach (SALA/MTA, based on Margaret Taylor Smith's *Multisensory Training Approach*), directed by **Chris Bedenbaugh**.
- 2) Shelton Academic Reading Approach (SARA, based on Scottish Rite Hospital's Take Flight curriculum), directed by **Nancy Coffman**. Nancy retired in June after 27 years of service and training more than 660 teachers.
- 3) Sequential English Education (SEE), directed by **Dr. Joyce Pickering**.

Each is accredited by the International Multisensory Structured Language Education Council (IMSLEC) and the International Dyslexia Association (IDA). This year, we trained 242 teachers using these three courses.

Currently, Shelton has training cohorts in Alabama, Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Utah and Texas.

**Jessica Newman** is the SEE and Association Method Supervisor. In this role, she organizes the SEE and Association groupings for Lower School, Upper Elementary and sixth grade in Middle School. She also helps train, supervise and observe all SEE and Association teachers. In addition, she is the coordinator of Shelton's Saturday and Summer Scholars offerings. Scholars provides remediation at a reasonable cost to children who cannot attend a full-time school like Shelton. The Shelton Scholars program was founded in 1991. This outreach offering has served students from every Independent School District and private school in the metroplex area.

On Jan. 14, we hosted the Academic Language Therapy Association (ALTA) Regional Summit conference. Coordinated by Shelton's **G-g Shryer**, there were 600 attendees.

**Dr. Laure Ames**, Director of Shelton's Evaluation Center (see pg. 8), conducted a virtual Screening for Dyslexia workshop Feb. 5. Attendees were from California, Colorado, Wisconsin, Arkansas, Mississippi and Texas.

We continue to offer six workshops a year to new Shelton parents.

- Overview of Learning Differences
- Simulations of Learning Differences
- Social Skills/Organization and Study Skills
- Oral and Written Language: Decoding, Spelling, Comprehension and Composition
- Freedom from Chemical Dependency
- Math, Science and Social Studies

On April 29 and 30, we were pleased to be a gold sponsor of the ALTA National Conference in Colorado Springs, Colo.

On May 11, **Chris Bedenbaugh** graduated from Lamar University's accelerated Educational Diagnostician certificate program and passed the certification exam on June 10. Meghan Miller was her site supervisor, **Dr. Laure Ames** provided mentorship throughout the practicum and the Technology Department provided her with assistance that allowed her to be successful. Chris was the recipient of tuition support from Shelton. She is very grateful for all the support she received.

**Sara Harris** and **Jennifer Drake** are coordinating *Summer, the Shelton Way*, which will be held in June.

# SHELTON OUTREACH IS EVERYWHERE

Joyce S. Pickering, Hum.D., Shelton Executive Director Emerita



**Dr. Joyce Pickering**, Shelton's Executive Director Emerita, directs the Multisensory Structured Language Education (MSLE) courses in Sequential English Education (SEE). She also co-directs the Shelton Montessori Training (SMT). She is a SEE instructor, Montessori instructor and field consultant and presenter of workshops and conferences worldwide.

Dr. Pickering created the Montessori Applied to Children with Learning Differences (MACAR) course in 1990 and as President of the American Montessori Society she initiated the additional program of AMS endorsement in Montessori Inclusion. Shelton Montessori Training is the only recognized course for this endorsement.

For the last two years, the MSLE and MACAR courses have been hybrid, and this year we are also offering onsite courses again.

SEE Training was offered three times in 2022 with a total of 32 adult learners registered in the Teaching, Therapy and Instructor levels. Thirteen Shelton teachers were trained in SEE during this period. This year, 34 teachers completed training to certification at the Teaching Level, three at the Therapy Level and two at the Instructor Level. **Danyle Duke** is the coordinator of the SEE training course.



The **MACAR** course, offered virtually in July, had 19 participants in the Beginning course with **Joyce Pickering**, **Christine Davis** and **Amy Cushner** instructing. We also had six teachers attend the Advanced course virtually with **Amy Cushner** and **Laure Ames**. We look forward to offering both the Beginning and Advanced MACAR courses again this summer.

Joyce Pickering and **Gulzar Babool** also presented the MACAR course to students at Trine University in Indiana.

Off-site programs coordinated by the Executive Director Emerita's office include the May Center in Santa Fe, N.M., the Bridgemark School in Tyler, Texas, and the ASPIRE adult literacy program in Dallas.

A major initiative is the **North Mississippi Literacy Program**, now in its second year. This project was funded by **Bob** and **Carol Dorsey** for more than \$1 million for a three-year Early Intervention Literacy Project for preschool through second grade. One hundred and twenty teachers have received training in the SEE program and data is being collected on 600 students as they proceed in the program through their preschool and

early elementary school years. The goal is to raise the number of students who pass the state third-grade literacy test. The research on this program will be published at the end of the study in summer 2024. The Director of the NMLP is Shelton staff member **John Hodges**, who moved to Oxford, Miss., to direct and supervise the program.

## Montessori Training

**Gulzar Babool** is the Director of Shelton Montessori Training. We offer American Montessori Society (AMS) Affiliation and Montessori Accreditation Council for Teacher Education (MACTE) accredited certification in Early Childhood, Elementary I, Elementary II and Elementary I-II programs. We have an AMS-affiliated Montessori Administrator program to certify the principals and heads of schools in both public and private sectors. Our administrator course cohort includes nine principals, assistant principals and leaders from DISD, a director from a private school and a school leader from a Montessori School in Brazil. We are the first Teacher Education Program in the country to offer Montessori Inclusion Endorsement. This endorsement helps us share our knowledge and experience in effectively serving neurodiverse learners in the Montessori environment. We continue to be the designated training center for Dallas ISD to have their educators become AMS certified. Currently, we have two Early Childhood DISD cohorts and two Elementary I-II DISD cohorts enrolled in the program. In addition, we have more than 100 educators doing Montessori coursework and practicum, and we have 20 Montessori Instructors teaching our courses.



**Candace Collier** joined the team as a Montessori Associate to support efforts on all fronts, including photography of sessions, video coverage and gathering feedback. She has strengthened our presence on social media and marketing approaches and provides exceptional customer service to our educators and instructors. Join us on Instagram, where we have more than 500 followers!

Gulzar Babool has conducted professional development sessions for Dallas ISD and various schools in Texas. She even traveled to Denali Montessori School in Alaska for a three-day teacher training.

Gulzar Babool and **Cathy Luby** continue to conduct field visits to support our educators. SMT carries on, meeting the needs of our adult learners and school administrators to provide them with continuous support.

## Short-Term Workshops

A short-term workshop from Shelton instructors gives other schools the chance for their teachers to gain knowledge from our years of experience at Shelton. Providing these professional development workshops virtually allows us to reach even more teachers in more areas. This year, workshops were presented for groups in Dallas, Houston and Tyler, Texas, and as far away as Anchorage, Alaska. Shelton Outreach continues to serve students and teachers in the Dallas area and to provide information and training internationally in the unique Shelton Way.

# SHELTON EVALUATION CENTER

Laure Ames, Ph.D., Director



The Shelton Evaluation Center (SEC) had another busy year. Our staff worked with clients from the DFW area and from Louisiana, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Kansas, Alabama, New Mexico and Texas. Our goal when conducting an evaluation is to obtain a comprehensive picture of the client's functioning so that we can make appropriate recommendations for intervention and accommodation. Although

our primary evaluations are psychoeducational and assess problems with learning, many of our clients are also assessed for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

We have a highly trained and experienced staff to help in this process. I have years of both personal and professional experience that help me understand how to help children with learning difficulties. # MIDDLE SCHOOL NEWS

Middle School has 344 students and is busy with academics, electives, student council events, sports and after-school clubs. The students in our 36 advisories started the school year by getting to know each other with ice-breaker activities, games and the development of an advisory charter. In addition, students discussed social skills and worked on organizational and study strategies. Our scholars are hard at work in their reading, English, math, history and science classes. Middle School teachers use multi-sensory instruction to reach all types of learners.



## Electives

Middle School students take four electives every year, including band, drama, art, vocal music, STEM, LEGO robotics, Python coding, Life Hacks, Digital Music Production and more. Drama gives our students the opportunity to learn to work as a group, practice their social skills and stretch themselves in ways they never thought possible. From

the beginning audition to the final bow, a drama class at Shelton introduces students to the work of a theatrical production. Our eighth graders performed in the musical "Matilda JR" in December, seventh graders will appear in "21 Guaranteed Ways to Get A Detention" and sixth graders will stage "After Hours."



## Vocal Music

Our vocal music program is flourishing thanks to our beautiful new choir room located in the Moody Fine Arts Center. Vocal music elective classes focusing on musical theater and pop genres have been extremely successful. At the end of the first quarter, sixth- and seventh-grade classes performed vocal showcases for parents. Shelton Singers Honor Choir, an after-school activity, performed a fantastic fall concert. We use the engineering design process to brainstorm, design, test, redesign and retest until students have their final product.



## After-School Activities

Several clubs keep our students engaged in a variety of interests and connected with classmates. Students in Knits and Knots learned to make scarves, friendship bracelets, backpack tags and key chains to give to new students at the Student Council New Student Party. Improv and Drama Club students enjoyed improvisational scene work and character study among other drama games and activities.



## Robotics Team Takes First Place

Congratulations to our MS Robotics Team for their win at the scrimmage tournament on Nov.

19. The team included **Maren Price, Brent Venable, Mark Jansen, Colin Garcia** and **Jack Shell** and is coached by **Sara Harris**.

Combining colorful LEGO building elements, easy-to-use hardware and an intuitive drag-and-drop coding language based on Scratch, SPIKE Prime engages students through learning activities to think critically and solve complex problems, regardless of their learning level. From easy-entry projects to limitless creative design possibilities, SPIKE Prime helps our students learn essential STEAM skills. In addition to the LEGO Robotics elective, the robotics team competed in December against 30 North Texas teams in the 2022 Super Powered Challenge. Players engage in research, problem solving, coding and engineering as they build and program a LEGO Education robot that navigates the missions of a robot game. As part of the Challenge this year, students explored energy sources and how it is stored, distributed and used in our community. They then designed and created a solution that will improve energy to be more efficient, reliable, affordable, accessible or sustainable.

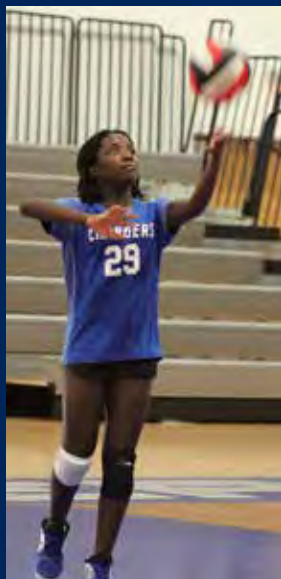


## Life Hacks

This is the third year for our seventh and eighth graders to participate in Life Hacks, a practical, fun and confidence-building class modeled after the Home Economics class of days gone by. 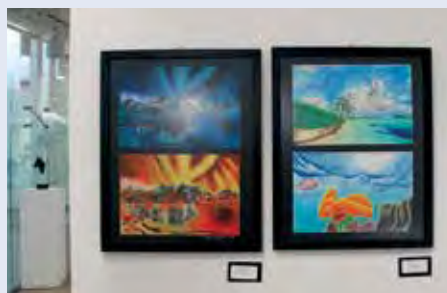
# FINE ARTS FEATURES

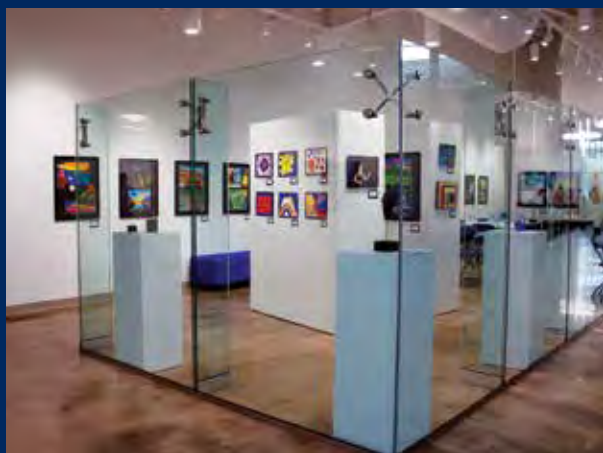
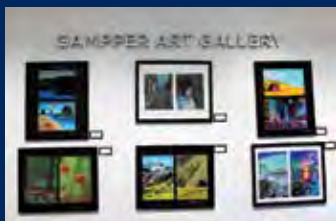
- The Gampper Art Gallery, located in the lobby of the Moody Fine Arts Center, features rotating works by Shelton art students of all grade levels.

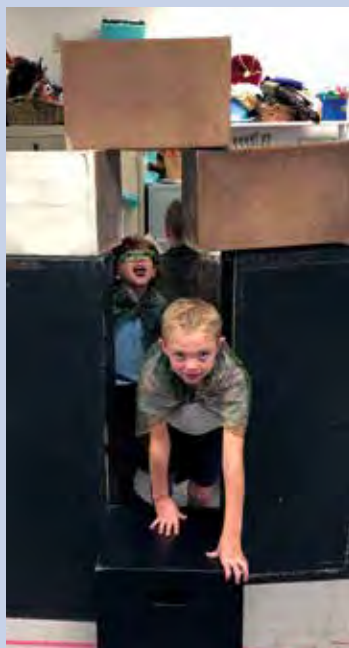

Shelton librarians provide curriculum support and research guidance, along with books and information, for students, teachers, parents, staff and the administration. We strive to make our services, materials and instruction appropriate for meeting the needs of students with learning differences. This year library classes researched

topics, evaluated resources, honed technology skills, practiced digital citizenship and took care of library pets. Middle School and Upper School students stayed in the library to read, do homework, use textbooks, complete projects and study. In addition, Upper School students participated in a new volunteer opportunity this year that incorporated the Lower School library. They received community service hours by organizing the library with librarians and helping students with books and reading before school.

## Inspiring Authors

In March, author and ultramarathoner **Dion Leonard** and his dog, Gobi, presented "Finding Gobi" to appreciative Lower School and Upper Elementary

students. The book tells the tale of Gobi, a lost dog who kept pace with the author across a vast desert, and his struggle to bring her home for good. The students enjoyed hearing them share their exciting, true story.

Annually, all Middle School students read one book together during every class period for one week. This year, they chose to read "The Running Dream" by Wendelin Van Draanen. To kick off the reading event, Wendelin, the author of the book, held a Zoom visit for all students. She shared her writing inspirations and answered questions from the Middle School students.

## Reading Events

Shelton librarians encourage our students to read a variety of authors and genres on their own. Throughout the year we offer reading challenges where our students can connect with new ideas and experiences by reading many different kinds of books. Challenges included the Bluebonnet Reading Challenge, Trot into Reading and Learning Ally Games. Students were able to read independently or with a family member. Celebrations were held for participants, allowing students to display their projects and enjoy popsicles and ice cream with their friends and families. This year our students read more than 2,000 books just through these reading programs.

All Shelton students competed in their first ever Learning Ally Games. Students read digital and audio books throughout the year using the Learning Ally program. Shelton placed third in Texas and seventh nationwide by reading 130,436 pages. It was an excellent result for our first year with Learning Ally.

## Professional Development

Librarians provided professional development sessions for Shelton teachers to share databases, research and technology strategies during Inservice. Three librarians attended the annual Texas Librarian Association Conference in Fort Worth. They were able to use this valuable time to network and connect with others in the library community, meet authors and keep updated with emerging professional trends.



## New Role

**Deanna Wallace** moved from Middle School science to the Middle School librarian position. She came to Shelton in 2019 from the Richardson school district. She has more than 17 years experience in the Middle School library.

# TECHNOLOGY TRENDS

The Technology Team supports Shelton's four entities — the School, Evaluation Center, Speech/Language/Hearing Center and Outreach & Training.

School began in August with all students learning on campus. With the technological challenges of COVID behind us, the Technology Team is now focused on refinements to our infrastructure. With the help of a skilled network engineer, we have fine-tuned our network to ensure strong Wi-Fi access both within the building and in several areas outside of the building. In addition, we've heightened our attention to both individual and network security. The KnowBe4 System was rolled out to our staff in December 2021 to give everyone practice in sniffing out phishing-type email messages.

In addition, each staff member attended a cyber security class taught by **Chris Brendel**, Coordinator of Instructional Technology.

On the student side, we rolled out #WinAtSocial to students in fourth-twelfth grades. As technology is native to our students, we feel a strong responsibility to guide our students to use technology in responsible, character-forward ways.

Partnering with parents, the end goal is to guide our students to be upstanding citizens of the digital world.

Many of our freshmen and sophomores completed community service at Feed My Starving Kids, Love Pacs and United to Learn.

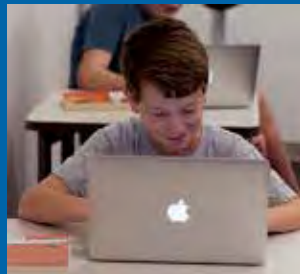
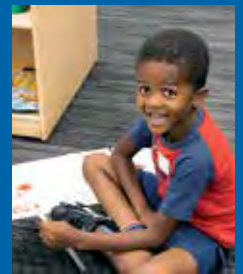




# SUMMER, THE SHELTON WAY

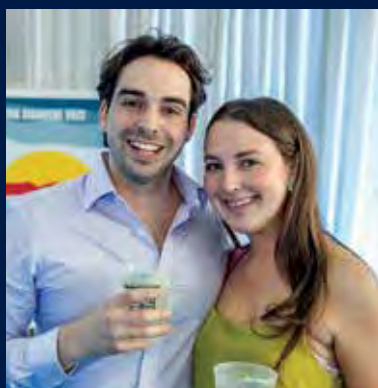

"The aspect that I believe has helped me to succeed to the level I have today is the personal relationships I have built with my teachers as well as the confidence they have in me," he said. He has been accepted to Texas A&M, where he plans on majoring in Rangeland, Wildlife and Fisheries Management with an emphasis on aquaculture and fisheries.
