A Place to Learn and Grow

White Bear Lake Area Preschool provides a safe and nurturing environment for a child's first school experience. Daily activities help children develop social and emotional skills that are a key for future school success. Licensed teachers provide a variety of meaningful hands-on learning experiences in the areas of reading and math readiness, science and social studies, art and sensory, music, and dramatic play. Our language arts curriculum is aligned with the district's kindergarten curriculum so our preschoolers will be well prepared for learning to read and write.

Play Based Learning

Play is the foundation upon which all preschool learning is built. As such, free-choice play times are incorporated into our preschool day, as well as guided play-based learning activities that are designed to teach children a specific skill. Children will experience hands-on and creative activities that will stimulate their learning while allowing the freedom to explore their environment and express their creativity. This play-based learning philosophy is supported by our guiding curriculum: the Creative Curriculum for Preschool.

Conscious Discipline

White Bear Lake Early Childhood uses Conscious Discipline, which is an innovative social-emotional learning and classroom management framework. Conscious Discipline teaches children self-regulation skills for everyday life. This is taught by helping children to identify and name their feelings, and use breathing and calming strategies to regulate.

Parent Aware Rated

WBLAS Preschool Program is a four-star Parent Aware rated Program. Parent Aware is a statewide quality rating system for programs that demonstrate best practice for early education. Programs that receive a four-star rating are the highest quality programs in the state.

Serving All Children

We are an inclusive community. Our commitment to diversity and inclusion creates a culture of equity for children and families. We celebrate our differences and we recognize that children bring their own unique cultural strengths to our classrooms.

Special Education

Special education services are provided for children on IEPs within our program. Preschool teachers, Special Education teachers and Specialists work together to support all students.

Family Engagement

Meaningful family engagement in children's learning supports school readiness and later academic success. Here are some ways for you to support your student:

- Attend your child's preschool orientation meeting at the beginning of the year
- Ensure your child's regular attendance at school
- Attend conferences twice a year with your child's teacher
- Read the communication that comes from your child's teacher, and reach out if your child needs support
- Attend school events throughout the year

Early Childhood Screening

Early Childhood Screening is required by the state of Minnesota for all children prior to entering kindergarten. Screening offers a snapshot of each child's health and development and provides families with valuable information about their child. Screening children between ages three and four, allows time for intervention (if needed) before the start of Kindergarten. For this reason, we require Early Childhood screening within the first 90 days of the start of the preschool year. White Bear Lake School District provides the screening at no charge to families. Screenings are held at Normandy Park on Fridays throughout the school year. Please contact our main office at 651-653-3100, if you have any questions regarding screening.



Full Day Preschool

Full Day Preschool: 5 Days (M-F)

Age 4 by Sept 1, 2024

This full day, year-before-kindergarten program is designed to help children prepare to enter kindergarten with the skills and behaviors necessary to be successful. Children who are four years old on or before September 1 of the current school year and are bathroom independent are eligible to enroll.

Otter Lake will have one classroom that spends 2 hours outside every morning. Families will have the choice between this nature based option or a more traditional classroom option.

Mon-Fri, 7:45 am-2:15 pm

Program Sites: Birch, Lakeaires, Oneka, Otter, Willow, and Vadnais

Additional Options: May qualify for transportation, Access to Nutrition Services (free breakfast and lunch at all elementary sites), and Extended Day offered at these locations

Dates: September 9, 2024-June 6, 2025
(follows the WBL preschool calendar)

Cost: \$970 per month (Sept 1-May 1)

For 3-5 year olds

The program at Tamarack Nature Center revolves around nature - learning from it, about it and within it. Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

In Every Classroom Our Program Provides:

- Minnesota licensed teachers and trained assistants
- *Creative Curriculum* used as the guiding instructional framework
- *Handwriting Without Tears* curriculum
- *Conscious Discipline & Second Step* framework & curriculum for social emotional learning
- Literacy framework that aligns to the district's kindergarten standards
- Ongoing assessment using *Teaching Strategies Gold* to measure student growth

Toileting

All preschool students should be mostly bathroom independent, knowing when they need to use the bathroom and having few accidents. For elementary sites children must be independent with toileting without the use of a pull-up or a diaper to attend preschool classes.

**Special circumstances are accommodated for children with an IEP or 504 plan*

Transportation

For full day preschool students at elementary sites, busing may be provided if space permits and you live within the school attendance boundary. There is no transportation for half day preschool classes or full day preschool at Normandy Park or Tamarack.

Extended Day

Families who are registered for full day preschool at elementary buildings, can register for Extended Day at those school sites. Registration for the 2024-2025 school year for Extended Day opens April 1. Registration is first come, first served and slots fill quickly. Please plan to register your child right away. Preschool Meals

Students attending full day classes at elementary sites will have access to school meals, and will be issued a food service PIN to use when eating school breakfast and lunch. This number will stay with your child throughout their school years in White Bear Lake. Students attending full day classes at Normandy Park and Tamarack will need to bring lunch from home each day and eat breakfast before arriving at school.



Outdoor Play

Outdoor time is an important part of the school day for our children. Our preschool classes go outside everyday, weather permitting.

How To Register for Preschool

To register for preschool, visit the White Bear Lake Area Schools Early Childhood registration website at earlychildhood.isd624.org/registration. A confirmation email will be sent when your student has been placed in their class and your payment account will be charged.

(This process can take up to 15 business days)



Class Fees

Class fees are based on the program costs for the entire year. Parents will be invoiced a monthly fee based on these costs. Payments are due the first day of each month. Tamarack Nature Preschool fees are higher to cover the costs of a Ramsey County Naturalist.

Payment Options

We offer payment options to assist families with payments. Payments are due the first of each month.

Students outside of the White Bear Lake Area School District boundary attending Tamarack Nature Preschool, will be charged an additional non-refundable \$100.00 fee.

Screen at Three

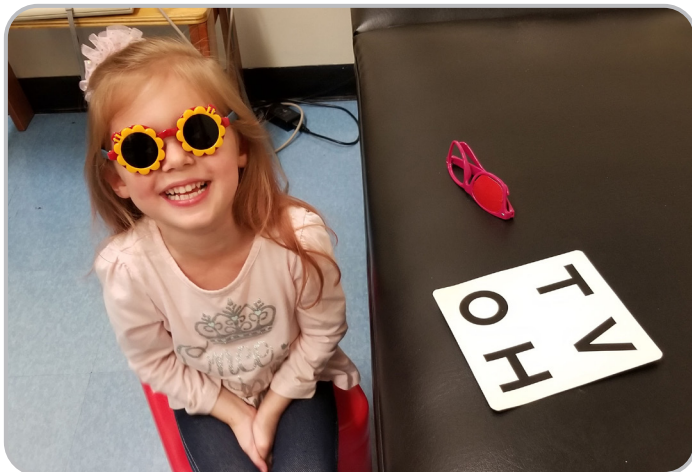
Early Childhood Screening is required by the state of Minnesota for all children prior to entering kindergarten. White Bear Lake Area School District provides this screening at no charge.
