- Review STAR 360 and 5 Essentials

STAR - goal to increase by 10%, we had an increase of 51 students that did not start at or above grade level but finished above grade level

Reading

28 students that did decrease a level.

39% in fall at or above, goal to get to 49% we had 225 students of 90% of target.

Net of +23 in Reading

Math

increased by 31 student that increased.

23 decreased

85 students 16% increased so we hit 69% of target – district wide only at 50%. Math is a area we need to get increased

Star growth is 52 in Reading (one year's growth in one year's time)

Star growth is 46 in Math (one year's growth in one year's time)

School improvement plan goal – CMAS goal is 52, results not in but with Star 23 of we should be good at 50 (reading) goal of 46 (math)

Excited about the English opportunity and results. Math is an improvement but not at pace we would like.

Confident we will hit goal of 'meet expectations' esp if we hit the CMAS goals if Star results track.
