CAMPAIGNING IN SCHOOLS

District employees shall not advocate for or against Board candidates, budgets, or propositions during working hours. The following activities by District employees are specifically prohibited:

1. Using District property including but not limited to mailing labels, postage, telephones, and photocopying equipment to advocate for or against a Board candidate, budget or proposition.
2. Permitting outside organizations to use District property to advocate for or against a Board candidate, budget or proposition.
3. Engaging in any activity with students during working hours which advocates for or against a Board candidate, budget or proposition.

This policy does not prohibit the distribution of factual non-partisan information concerning school district elections.
