What is 23g?

These funds are designated to support students before, during and after school to address unfinished learning. These funds are targeted toward students who may fall behind their peers in grade level standards.

Implementation of funds

WPS will use funds to enhance evidence based instructional practices in tier 2 and 3. The students will be given additional instructional support with current teaching staff and or paraprofessional. WPS will use funds to support identified students for tier 2 and 3 academic intervention. WPS will use the MTSS process to identify students that are behind academically and provide the appropriate interventions.

23g Reporting Measures

Program measures are based on NWEA, local assessment, M-STEP, and other diagnostic measures used in reading and math. Monitoring will consist of District and school reports.
