Rolling Report

The rolling report continues to show a projected loss at year-end. However, the
projected deficit is far smaller than last month due to another great month. We
were hoping to hit break-even by the end of Q2 but the timing is likely not going
to work out.

Board Report pg.1

- This continues to be a more detailed recap of the rolling report.
 - o Overall, we took in \$900,000 more than we spent.
 - o Encumbrances remain flat.
 - o Outstanding invoices are looking great.
 - Billing cycles for our programs dictate this timeline (in arrears)
 - 80% were issued in the last 30 days.
 - One invoice over 90 days.

District/County pg.2

 We are continuing to see the usage of these funds as you will see under the District/County contracts. Most of the focus has been on growing the fiscal staff in our Montgomery County districts through the SRCs Pathways Program.

Investments pg.2

- We still have just one CD on the books.
 - Hoping to add to this in the coming months

All Other Funds pg.3

- We continue to seek out and add new grants as shown in the acceptance of funds on this agenda.
- Our largest deficit continues to be EANS.
 - o We are in the last year of this funding currently serving 25 non-public schools

Three-Year Comparison pg.4

- There has been a steady increase in both receivables and expenditures over the last few years as the business continues to grow.
- Outstanding invoices are low in comparison to prior years. This is a result of the timing of billing. We are continuing to tweak invoice timelines to better accommodate the districts we are serving.

Final Notes

- Most programs are continuing to run at or slightly ahead of the Master Plan.
 - o The variances in most programs do not have much of an impact on the budget.
 - However, there are a few programs that can vary only slightly and it would have a significant impact on our bottom line.
 - These are the ones we are keeping our eyes on.
- End-of-year numbers will continue to fluctuate as we progress through the year.
 There is no reason to expect anything other than what was projected at this point.

BOARD RESOLUTION

The Board of Education (the "Board") of the Montgomery County ESC, Ohio, (the "School District") met in general session December 14, 2023, at 4:30p.m., at the offices of the Board, 200 S. Keowee Street, Dayton, Ohio with the following members present:

Mr. Greg Shell, Mr. Terry Smith, Mr. Gary Roberts, Mr. Daryl Michael, Mr. Tomas Steck, Mrs. Shannon Cox, Mr. Christopher Fox

Mr. Greg Shell introduced the following resolution and moved its passage.

AUTHORIZING SOUTHWESTERN OHIO EDUCATIONAL PURCHASING COUNCIL, ACTING JOINTLY AS A MEMBER OF THE OHIO SCHOOL CONSORTIUM ("CONSORTIUM")¹, TO ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMPETITIVE RETAIL NATURAL GAS SERVICE FROM THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER SUBMITTED TO CONSORTIUM AND AUTHORIZING THE BOARD TO PURCHASE COMPETITIVE RETAIL NATURAL GAS SERVICE FROM SUCH BIDDER.

WHEREAS, the School District is a member of SOUTHWESTERN OHIO EDUCATIONAL PURCHASING COUNCIL, a body authorized by state statute to aggregate the purchasing needs of schools and of related nonprofit educational entities so as to take advantage of economies of scale when purchasing essential products and services;

WHEREAS, in prior years, the SOUTHWESTERN OHIO EDUCATIONAL PURCHASING COUNCIL has joined with other school districts and educational purchasing councils, acting jointly as a member of the Consortium, to conduct a Request for Proposal ("RFP") for competitive natural gas service commencing on or about mid-February 2024;

WHEREAS, through prior RFP processes, the Consortium has selected the lowest and best bids submitted in response to RFPs; and the School District has previously elected to enter into a Master Supply Agreement with the lowest and best bidder for competitive retail natural gas service for all of the School District's natural gas supply;

WHEREAS, the Consortium intends to issue a new RFP for competitive retail natural gas service commencing with the July 2025 billing cycle and terminating no later than the end of the June 2030 billing cycle for participating school districts and education purchasing councils;

WHEREAS, the School District wishes to participate in this upcoming RFP process and potentially execute a Master Service Agreement with the lowest and RFP bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee will review the lowest and best bid and corresponding terms when the RFP is concluded and determine whether the RFP resulted in the lowest and best bid for competitive retail natural gas service for all of the School District's natural gas supply.

¹ The members of the Consortium are the Metropolitan Education Council, the Ohio Mid-Eastern Regional Education Service Agency, the Southwestern Ohio Educational Purchasing Council, the Stark County Schools Council of Governments, Columbus City Schools, and South-Western City Schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY MONTGOMERY COUNTY ESC OF MONTGOMERY, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Education of the School District does hereby consent, as a member of the SOUTHWESTERN OHIO EDUCATIONAL PURCHASING COUNCIL, to the conducting of an RFP process by the Consortium for competitive retail natural gas service commencing with the July 2025 billing cycle and terminating no later than the end of the June 2030 billing cycle, with bids to be submit ed for one, two and three year periods on such terms and conditions as the Consortium deems appropriate.

Section 2. The Board of Education of the School District does hereby authorize the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee to execute a Master Supply Agreement between the School District and the lowest and best bidder in the RFP so long as the Superintendent or his appointee finds that the price reflects the results of a public and competitive RFP process.

Section 3. The Board of Education hereby directs the Treasurer to review the lowest and best bid once received and the Master Supply Agreement and determine if the School District has sufficient funds to certify this resolution and, if the Treasurer so finds, to certify this resolution.
