



Course Selection Roadmap






Freshman Schedule

- 5. Elective 1: World Language (recommended)
- 6. Elective 2: Fine art or applied academic
- 7. Ethnic Studies/Health (optional this year, space is limited)







AVID at Fremont High School

AVID Application Due Fri, March 1st

Application Process

- Student application + parent signature / acknowledgement
- Teacher recommendation (Google form)
- Interview (conducted after application/teach rec have been turned in)

You will have two options for submitting your application:

1. We have a paper version for the student application. These can be turned in to the red box marked "FHS AVID" at the front desk of your middle school office. The teach rec must be done through Google forms, even if the student application is turned in on paper.


Next Steps
