The ‘Say Something’ campaign is to provide students, staff, and parents an alternative option for reporting bullying incidents, sexual assault or harassment incidents, and school safety concerns.

Reports can be submitted by texting @SayIt to the number 833-769-0372 or using your phone’s camera to read the QR code on the posters on display throughout each school. When a report is received, the principal of the building indicated as the site of the concern will receive the full incident report via email.
