


2024/2025 Everest Adventure Care Before or After School & Camp

CONSTRUCTION IS MOVING AHEAD

As I write this, the heat has been turned on inside the arena and the tile is being installed. The drywall is up and painted with door frames and windows installed.

This facility is going to make an impact on the community and Central Wisconsin. The 135.000 square foot indoor turf facility will accommodate a full size field of 120 yards x 71 yards. As a community center, it will include space for youth and high school activities such as soccer, football, lacrosse, softball, baseball, golf, track & field, band and dance. The space will also will have the ability to host tournaments, camps, community events and individual user groups.

Now that winter has arrived, construction efforts are shifting to focus on finalizing intricate details. The drywall, paint, tile, and doorframes have all been completed. Additionally, large screens have been ordered to convey announcements, sponsor ads, scoreboards, and the ability to project games for an enhanced viewing experience. The installation of glass offers a spectacular view of the turf field. The facility caters to the entire community, from preschool classes during the day to walking time on the lanes during the winter and athletic practice after school. The meeting rooms are designed to comfortably accommodate 25-50 people, and the sport simulators will be installed in the spring, available for rent by the hour for families, leagues, and individuals to enjoy.
