





Godley Middle School

- 90,000 SF addition includes classrooms, CL&I expansion, cafeteria expansion, locker rooms, fine arts, tornado shelter
- Renovation includes Admin/Library relocation, finish updates, and system replacements such as HVAC and roof
- New 4-lane track and practice field
- 1,200 student capacity for grades 6–8

Recommendation

On behalf of the Godley ISD Long Range Planning Committee we recommend that the Godley ISD Board of Trustees call a bond election in May 2024 asking voters to authorize \$355 million dollars for construction and renovation of school facilities in the district including safety and security, technology, and the purchase of school buses.

Bonds to be issued as the growth continues. Expected increases in the tax base will create the bonding capacity needed to fund this plan.
