J.O. Wilson Modernization Community Survey Winter 2024

During the 2024-25 school year, J.O. Wilson is slated to begin a full-scale renovation to the school's building and outdoor spaces. We will move to a nearby swing site (850 26th St NE) in January of 2025 and return to a beautiful new campus in the fall of 2026.

This school year, the JOW community has an opportunity to tell DCPS and the architecture firm Perkins Eastman what matters most to us in the design of the new campus. The renovated facility is already quaranteed to include a 4,200 square foot gymnasium, a maker space, two new playgrounds, and many other upgrades outlined by DCPS. On top of those improvements, we also have a chance to ensure the school is uniquely ours. This survey is being conducted by the JOW PTA to identify community priorities to share with decisionmakers in this process.
