

How to enable flash player in Google Chrome to run interactive websites:

Step one:

Know the main web site address of the site you want. If it is for example:

<http://www.pbs.org/wnet/secrets/witches-curse-interactive-explore-salem/1579/>

You will only need to know www.pbs.org

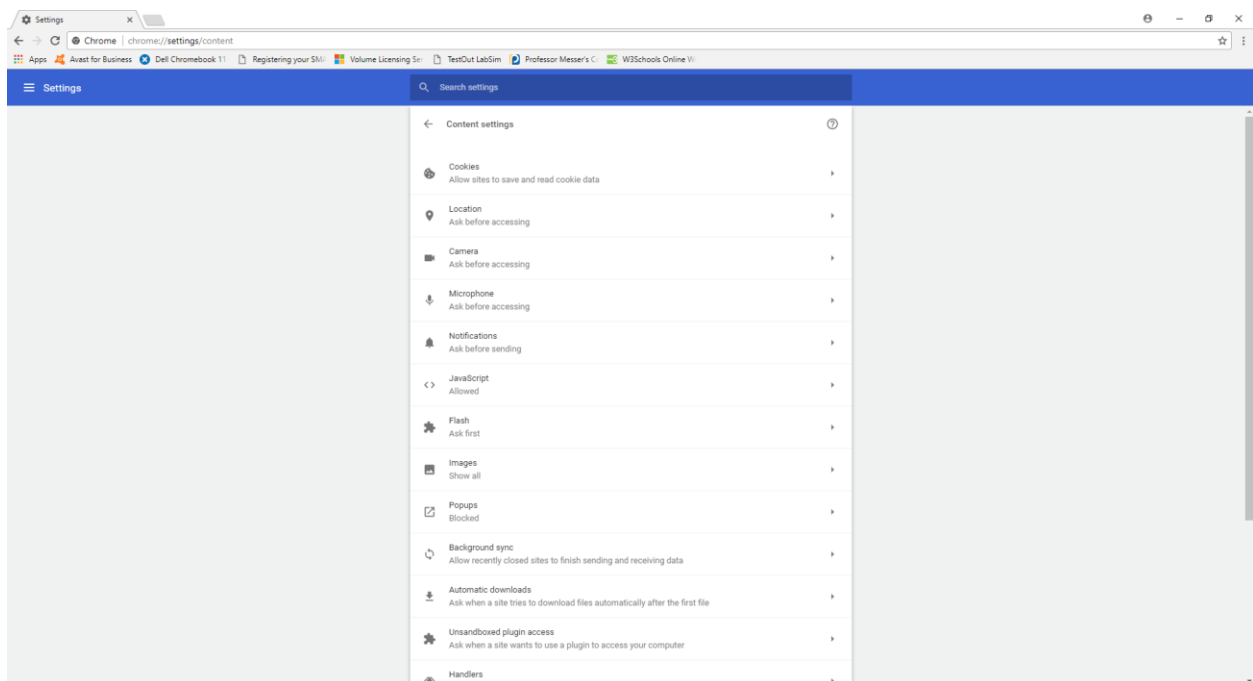
Step two:

Open Google Chrome.



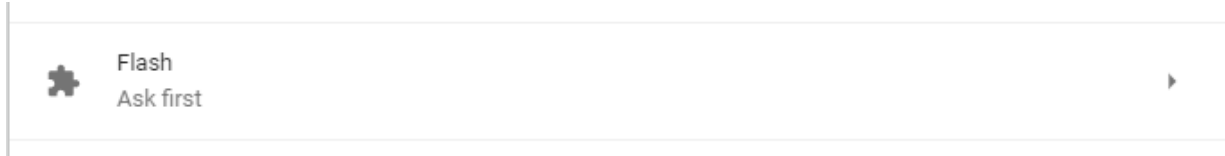
Step three:

Type `chrome://settings/content` in the web address bar. This will come up -

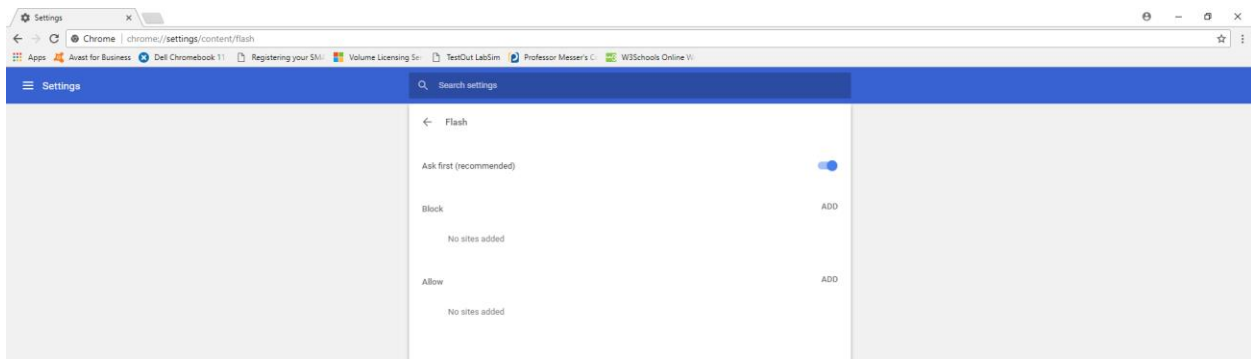


Step four:

Click on FLASH.



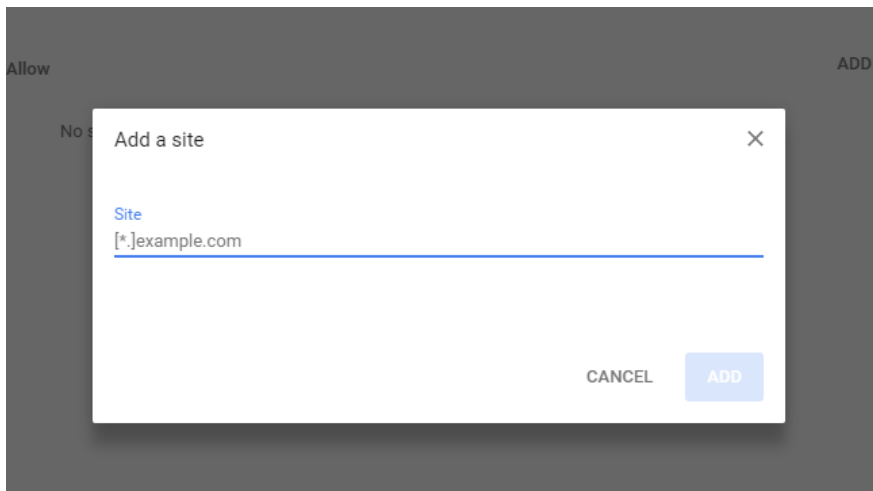
This will come up –



Step five:

Click **ADD** over to the right of the **Allow** spot.

When you do, it will pop up a typing box like this –



Type the web address you want to allow (figured out in step one) here and click ADD. Example www.pbs.org

Search settings

← Flash

Ask first (recommended)

Block ADD

No sites added

Allow ADD

www.pbs.org ⋮

It will automatically save when you click the ADD button so that is all you should need to do. You can now navigate back to whatever web site you wanted to use.
