Be Here/Be Ready:

Restroom Expectations



Be Here/Be Ready:

- Use the appropriate restroom.
- Use the restroom and come out as soon as you are done.

Be Respectful:

- Flush the toilet.
- Dispose of trash in the trashcan.
- Wash and dry your hands.
- Talk using a **level 1** voice.

Be Safe:

- Keep hands, feet and all other objects to yourself.
- Walk at all times.
- Clean any water spills that you make.

Be Positive:

- Wait for your turn.
- Honor other's privacy.
- Report anything inappropriate to an adult.

Hallway/Stairs Expectations



Be Here/Be Ready:

- Walk directly to your destination.
- Pay attention to what is going on around you.
- Listen carefully for any specific directions.

Be Respectful:

- Walk on the right side of the hallway.
- Talk using a **Level 0 or 1** voice.
- Use appropriate language.
- Wait your turn.

Be Safe:

- Walk facing forward on the right side of the hall.
- Touch every step on the stairway.
- Keep hands, feet and all other objects to yourself.
- Pick up any unwanted material in the hall.

Be Positive:

- Greet one another.
- Use appropriate and positive language.
- Assist others in need of help.

Cafeteria Expectations

Be Here/Be Ready:

- Be on time.
- Remain in the cafeteria at all times.
- Use the restroom only when necessary.
- Listen to your choice and answer in a polite manner.
- Go to the line when it's your turn and wait patiently.

Be Respectful:

- Follow cafeteria procedures.
- Eat your lunch using a fork or a spoon.
- Chew with your mouth closed.
- Use your manners.

Be Safe:

- Walk facing forward.
- Keep hands, feet and other objects to yourself.
- Clean up when you are finished.

Be Positive:

- Include others to sit with you.
- Assist others in need of help.
- Use a **level 1** voice when you are in the lunch line.
- Use a **level 2** voice when you are sitting at your table.
- Greet the workers who are serving you your meal.

- Leave no trace behind.
- Be prompt to line up.

Be Respectful:

- Follow staff directions.
- Follow game rules.

 <p>Waiting for the bus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay in designated area and visible to the driver Wait to approach the bus until the bus has stopped and the doors are open 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep hands, feet, and objects to self Respect private and public property 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be on time (5 minutes before pickup) Wait at your assigned stop Line up as directed
 <p>Entering the bus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use the handrail Walk at all times with space between you and the person in front of you Wait for driver's signal to cross or board 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Greet the bus driver Use kind and quiet voices 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be seated quickly and slide over Remain seated, facing forward Hold your backpack on your lap
 <p>Riding the bus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep the aisle clear Keep all objects inside the bus Be silent at railroad crossings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep hands, feet and objects to self Use a quiet voice Use appropriate language and topics Be prepared for your stop 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay seated, back to back, seat to seat, feet on the floor Keep food and drinks in your backpack Follow driver directions Report vandalism and bullying
 <p>Exiting the bus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay seated until the door opens Exit single file Hold the handrail If crossing, wait for driver's instruction, and cross in front of bus Walk in designated areas straight to your destination 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep an arms length between you and the person in front of you Keep aisle clear for students exiting Assist other students as needed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Report sleeping students to bus driver Get off at your assigned stop Take all personal items off the bus
 <p>Evacuation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay quiet, listen, and follow all adult instructions Leave belongings on the bus 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist other students as needed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay calm throughout the process Exit quickly and safely (one row at a time)
