





I understand that it is my responsibility to notify the Parkway-Rockwood Community Education Program in writing if I do not wish to be photographed or videotaped.

I have read this agreement as well as all Parkway-Rockwood Community Education, Parkway and Rockwood School District regulations, policies, procedures and consequences, fully understand its terms, and have voluntarily entered into this agreement of my own free will based only upon the terms and conditions included herein.
