Margaret's project, titled "A Novel Phosphosite Localization Approach Using Tandem Phosphoprotein Mass Spectra and Temporal Dilated Networks," and Elton's project, "National Ground-Level NO2 Predictions via Satellite Imagery-Driven Convolutional Neural Network," showcase their exceptional dedication and innovation in the field of academics and science research.
