

**Exhibit: Notice of Request for Service Animal**

To request approval to bring a service animal to school, fill out this form and return it to the School Director along with a certificate or report from a veterinarian demonstrating that the service dog has a vaccination license and is free of disease and proof that the dog has been spayed or neutered. You may not bring a service animal to school until this request is approved. You may be required to meet with the School Director to develop a plan prior to approval.

A "service animal" is defined by law as a dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. Only dogs are recognized as service animals under the ADA. Service animals are working animals, not pets. The work or task the dog has been trained to provide must be directly related to the person's disability.
