

Goals for 23-24 School Year

Goal #1 – Curriculum, Instruction, and Academic Achievement

Objectives:

1. Analyze and compare the past 3 years (2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23) of PSSA data which measures student achievement
 - a. Include in the analysis the class size numbers and the number of students with IEP's, number of students on behavior plans and number of students with 504's
2. Analyze and compare the past 3 years (2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24) of Aimsweb which measures student growth and student proficiency within the year
3. Evaluate success of 2nd year of Illustrative Math at the Middle School and 1st year of Language Arts Programs, Savaas MyView (K-2) and Amplify (Grades 3-8)
4. Review Curriculum Cycle twice during the 2nd Semester through Instruction Committee
 - a. Include progress updates and teacher feedback

Metrics:

1. PSSA - 2023-24 PSSA data will increase by the average increase over the last 3 years
2. Aimsweb - Measure the number of students that move on the benchmark scale (beginning of the year to the end of the year)
3. Math - ELA evaluation – Survey results from Building Administrators, MS math teachers, K-12 ELA teachers. Curriculum based assessments – unit tests, and other summative assessments (quizzes, projects)
4. Curriculum Cycle – Review progress twice during the 2nd Semester

Goal # 2 Student Achievement

Objective:

1. Improve the overall academic performance and rating of Twin Valley High School within Berks County, Pennsylvania and the United States

Metric:

U.S. News and World Report Ranking & Rating System

Goal # 3 Operational Management

Objective:

1. Develop a district wide management operating format for meetings which are all oriented to goals and operations of the district.

Metric:

1. Provide an acceptable format or structure for the Central office and building meetings to improve efficiency.

Goal # 4 - Student Participation

Objective:

1. Expand on Student engagement in all activities (i.e. clubs, extracurricular, sports, etc)

Metric:

1. Clear comparison of past two years and overall participation numbers should increase from the 2022-2023 baseline by 5%

Goal # 5 – Student Services

Objective:

1. Improve overall Student Services support related to behavior and emotional Support.

Metrics:

1. Analyze the out-of-district placement expenses, including tuition, student support, transportation and nursing services
2. Partner with Berks & Chester County I.U.'s for a thorough evaluation of the Student Services Department.
