

Ephrata Kiwanis Club Scholarship

The Ephrata Kiwanis Club will present at least three higher educational scholarships for varying amounts of at least \$1000 each this year. Two scholarships are awarded in memorial honor of former Kiwanians, Boyd Mordhorst and Earl Elliott. These scholarships are eligible for trade schools and higher-level educational institutes such as colleges and universities. Students in college are also eligible to apply.

Scholarship Guidelines:

1. The Kiwanis scholarship is given for use during the **second term (semester or quarter)** of college or trade school of choice.
2. The Kiwanis scholarship expires June 1st of the academic year after the year it is awarded.
3. The Kiwanis scholarship winner is required to attend one Kiwanis meeting by January 1st to validate the scholarship. We Kiwanians look forward to meeting our scholarship winners and hearing about your future. If you are unable to attend, please send us an email to Jenni Bates at jbates@chooseclear.com to explain why and let us know about your future plans, what College or Trade school you will be attending, and any extracurricular clubs or sports you might be joining.

Scholarship Requirements:

1. Attach a copy of your official high school transcript in a sealed envelope.
2. Provide at least 2 letters of recommendation from persons not related to you.
3. Attach additional papers if more room is needed while filling out the application.
4. Verification of enrollment is required from the institutions' registrar or financial aid office to verify your participation in school before we issue payment.
5. Return your completed scholarship application to the High School Counselor by April 14, 2024.
