



Hayward Unified School District Transportation Guidelines:

In preparation for the 2023-2024 school year, Hayward Unified School District is committed to continue to offer general education transportation services for eligible students. Continuing existing guidelines, students must live within the Hayward Unified School District boundary and meet the following requirements to be eligible:

1. Elementary students who live beyond the one and a half (1.5) mile walking distance from their home to their resident school.
2. Transportation may also be authorized within the walking distance when significant traffic related safety problems or hazards exist as part of the students walking route to school.
3. Elementary students who attend a school outside their resident school due to the district redirecting their placement.

For the 2023-2024 school year, we will provide transportation services to students attending the following schools:

- Burbank Elementary 2
- Cherryland Elementary 2
- East Avenue Elementary
- Eldridge Elementary
- Fairview Elementary
- Palma Ceia Elementary
- Park Elementary 2
- Southgate Elementary 2
- Stonebrae Elementary
- Treeview Elementary
- Tyrrell Elementary 2

Based on eligibility noted above, only for resident students who have significant traffic related issues as part of their walking route to school.

For the 2023-2024 school year, we will continue to provide transportation services from their resident school to middle school and high school students attending the following programs:

- a. Tennyson High School (World House Program Enrolled Students)
- b. Cesar Chavez Middle School (World House Program Enrolled Students)
- c. Eden ROP (High School Student)
