Integrating Your Preferences

Universal PreKindergarten (UPK) is the expansion of the state's mixed delivery system to meet the early education needs of 3 and 4-year-old children and their families, including Transitional Kindergarten (TK) which will be available for free to all 4-year-olds by 2025-2026.

UPK is an essential part of transforming California's schools and giving every student in California a great start. It provides a developmentally appropriate and academic environment that ensures all students experience success. UPK brings together all of these opportunities so families have more choices of high quality learning programs that meet their needs.


