PROBLEM BASED LEARNING AT CMS!

Our 6th and 7th grade students have been working extremely hard on their projects with Buckeye State Credit Union. Below is a short synopsis of what the expectation was for each grade level!

The 6th Grade group is participating in a "food truck frenzy." They are to take their idea and prepare a presentation for the Buckeye State Credit Union. The purpose of this presentation is to apply/receive a loan for their food truck company. Within the project there are five different roles in each group, which are as follows: financial planner, development manager, food truck designer, environmental specialist, and a chef.

The 7th Grade group is participating in a redesign of the BSCU because of a tornado catastrophe. Each group acts as an architectural design company where they are to create a blueprint and then turn it into a structure. For each of their firms they must create a business name, logo, and slogan. They are then to "pitch" their design to the BSCU on why their design should be chosen as the next BSCU.
