School Responsibilities

The Danville-Neel Elementary School will:

2. **Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least annually in elementary schools), during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.** Specifically, those conferences will be held:
 - o Conferences will be scheduled as needed through monthly mentoring/parent contacts
 - o Parent-Teacher Conference Day is September 18, 2023 and February 16, 2024.
3. **Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.** Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:
 - o Report Cards will be distributed on a nine-week grading cycle as well as data reports and SRIPs
 - o Progress Reports will be distributed in the middle of the grading cycle
 - o Weekly Classroom Newsletters
 - o Notes, phone calls, text messages, School Status, social media sites, and e-mails will be used as needed
4. **Provide parents reasonable access to staff.** Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:
 - o Parents may contact the school at any time to arrange a conference with their child's teacher
 - o Conferences/consultation may be scheduled before, during, or after the school day via phone, Google Meet, email, or in-person
5. **Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:**
 - o Maintain an environment for parents to visit and /or volunteer in the classroom while following school procedures
 - o Encourage parents to participate in parenting activities, such as, Title I Parent Involvement Meetings, PTO, classroom, and school events
6. **Ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, and, to the extent practicable, in a language that family members can understand.**
 - o Documents will be translated and interpreters will be provided as needed

Parent Responsibilities

We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- o Daily review my child's assignments with him/her and answer any questions

- o Spend at least fifteen minutes a day reading with my child
