DUAL ENROLLMENT

- High school students 9th-12th grade may enroll in college-level courses **TUITION-FREE** regardless of residency status
 - Student is responsible for fees and textbook/material costs
- Open to all CA high school students
- Students will earn college credit
- Students will be in classes with the general college population.

CCAP DUAL ENROLLMENT

College and Career Access Pathways (CCAP) is a formal partnership between a high school district and a community college district.

BENEFITS:

- Zero cost to students (no tuition, fees, OR textbook costs)
- Receive dual college credit AND high school credit
- Most classes UC and CSU transferrable
- Classes can go towards a certificate or degree
- Early exposure to college-level coursework
- Opportunity to explore potential majors and career paths
- Restricted enrollment to FUHSD students only
- Open to all FUHSD students
- Support and guidance with enrollment process

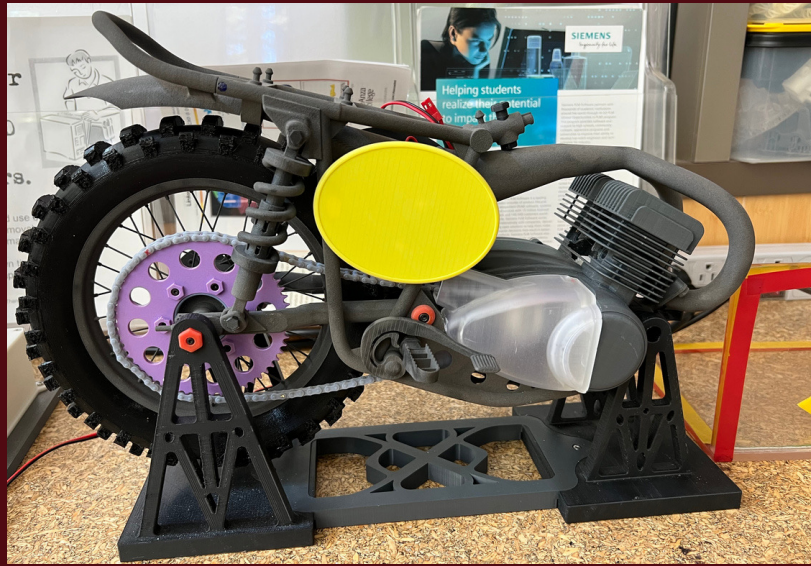
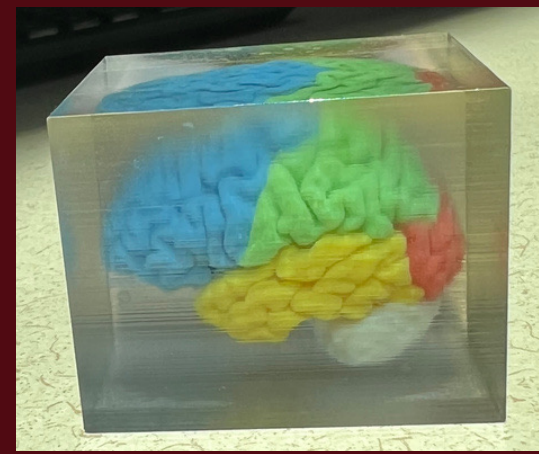

DUAL ENROLLMENT STEPS

1. Apply to De Anza via CCC Apply

- Will receive Campus Wide ID (CWID) within three business days
- No need to reapply if student is already taking a class

2. Complete the High School Permission Form

- Note: this is different than the High School CCAP form!
- HS Permission form requires signatures from student, parent, high school counselor

3. Register.

- a. CCAP: Admissions will process and register you into the class
- b. Non-CCAP: You will register yourself in your desired course section after Admissions processes your form.
