The National Honor Society is a national service organization for which students are selected to apply based on their scholarship (90+ weighted average). Admitted students show exemplary leadership, service and character.

At the end of the first semester of eleventh grade, students who meet the scholarship requirement will receive a written invitation to apply to our chapter of NHS.

Please read the NHS Eligibility Requirements portion below to see how members are selected. Following notification, a formal induction ceremony is held at the school to recognize all the newly selected members.

Once accepted, members are required to provide tutoring service to students grades 5-10, volunteer hours to the school community, and create new projects aimed at bettering our school community.

NHS Eligibility Requirements:

1. Students must have earned a cumulative high school GPA of 90 or above at the end of 1st semester of junior year (January/February).
2. Students must complete all necessary forms and attend the mandatory informational meeting to be considered for membership. These forms must be returned to the NHS advisors by the given deadline, which will be announced at our informational meeting.
3. Eligible and interested students should prepare their leadership activities and service hours/experiences as those will be significant to the application process.
4. Recommendations may be required.
5. A complete review of the students' disciplinary folder will occur in consideration of acceptance into NHS. This includes plagiarism, cheating, and any ethical concerns such as bullying. Students will have the opportunity to address any transgressions or misconceptions on their application.
6. Students will be notified of their acceptance in writing. All decisions are final.
