Dear Rebel Nation:

Happy New Year! We are excited to enter 2022 and look forward to an abundance of learning opportunities. We hope that your family had a wonderful holiday season. Classes will resume on Tuesday, January 4, 2022. We look forward to growing the intellectual capacity of our future generations in the new year.

We would like to congratulate our students, staff, and community. US NEWS and REPORTS ranked both Crestview Elementary and Crestview Middle School as one of Ohio's Best Schools. Which means that we rank in the top 30% of schools in the state of Ohio. This is a tremendous accomplishment for our students, staff, and the whole community. I personally want to thank everyone for their innovation and creativity.

January is a month where we lack some daylight. However, we have some bright stars here in Rebel Nation. We have the cure for the winter blahs! We invite you to come out and watch our students excel. We have plenty of basketball, wrestling, and bowling home matches in the coming weeks. Our home bowling matches are held at Hunt Club Lanes in Salem. In addition, our robotics team will be participating in some local tournaments as they prepare for the county championship to be held on Saturday, February 5, 2022, at Crestview High School. Our local bonds for building construction have sold with an average rate of 3.21%. This is an excellent rate and is unexpectedly low. We will hear more on the state contributions in late spring as the state moves forward after limited work during the pandemic. The current model of straight rows to prepare students will change to spaces equipped for invention and discovery. We have great partners and opportunities. We need to make sure that our physical space matches the needs for this type of learning. The future of our nation depends on us evolving to graduate students who are employable. It will be up to us to provide them with the spaces needed to explore. Currently, we hope that you get a chance to view our new manufacturing lab that just opened in our current building. The workforce is changing and we will need to continue to change with it. We must evolve to meet the needs of tomorrow and not the needs of the past. This evolution is what has made the Rebel Nation great for decades.




















THE WORKMAN FAMILY GIFT EXCHANGE
