

With the retirement of Mr. Matthew Manley, I was honored to be asked to lead the district for the next three years. Other changes to our district include some enhancements being made to our safety protocols and plans. Student and staff safety is one of my top priorities. Our board recently approved the purchase of new radios to be used by staff, we will be implementing identification badges for all staff and we will be looking at evacuation and fire drills to be sure we are using the best practices to ensure student and staff safety. Our biggest change to safety within the Crestview Local School District is the hiring of a full time school resource officer. The state of Ohio has recently awarded Crestview funding for a new pre-K-12 building. The project had been put on hold due to COVID-19 but we are back on track and have recently been meeting with the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission (OFCC) to develop plans to move forward. We will continue to provide updates on this exciting project as we are able.

TRANSPORTED STUDENTS

PARKING PERMITS

Student drivers **must** purchase a parking permit for the 2022-2023 school year. The permits will be issued on a first come-first serve basis. ***Parking spaces are numbered this year to know which vehicle belongs to which students, as part of our district safety plan.*** Student Parking Forms are available online under the high school page, and should be completed as soon as possible. Students must have the forms **authorized digitally by their parents, bring a copy of your valid driver's license, proof of insurance (copy for our records) and \$20.00** (cash or check payable to Crestview Schools) at the time of purchasing their permit. All student drivers must have a parking sticker and participate in the student random drug screening if they have not already done so as a student athlete.

REBEL FOOTBALL Discount Cards are on sale now for \$10.00. Please see any football player or coach to purchase yours.

SCHOOL COMPUTERS: Crestview computers that students took home over the summer should be turned on and allowed to run updates the first week of August. If your student is experiencing any technical difficulties, please have them send a Help Ticket to the Tech Department so any issues can be addressed BEFORE the school year starts. Students will be expected to start the school year on the first day since they will have their computers prepared to use.
