12th GRADE IMMUNIZATIONS 2022-23

Immunization Requirements for students entering 12th grade in the fall of 2022:

Students are required to have:

2 doses of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) vaccine.

If your child received the first dose of the vaccine after his/her 16th birthday, a second (2nd) dose is not required.



7th GRADE IMMUNIZATIONS FALL 2022-23

Immunization Requirements for students entering 7th grade in the fall of 2022:

Students are required to have the following immunizations:

1 dose of Tdap Vaccine

1 dose of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) vaccine.

We must have proof of these immunizations in order for your child to begin 7th grade. If your child has already received these immunizations, please send a copy of the record to the school as soon as possible. If your child has not received these immunizations, please contact your healthcare provider as soon as possible to schedule an appointment. It is important to plan ahead as it may be difficult to get an appointment closer to the start of school in the fall.

The Immunization Record must be received before August 23, 2022. Records can be mailed or faxed 330-482-5369 or hand delivered to the office. Please contact Janet Leipheimer, School Nurse, at 330-482-4744 Ext. 40117 with any questions regarding these requirements.

May 2-6



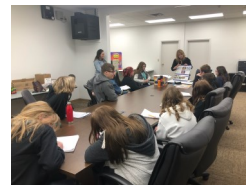

Dress clothing is required under gown: Black slacks, white or cream color shirt & tie, and black or dark dress shoes. Black, white, or black & white dress/skirt and top combo, and dress shoes or sandals with a back, in black, white or buff color with no spike heels (it will sink into the turf). Wedge or thick heel will work. It will be warm under the gown, dress accordingly per the weather and if indoors or outdoors.

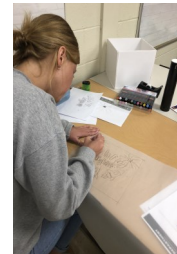
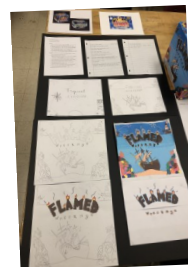
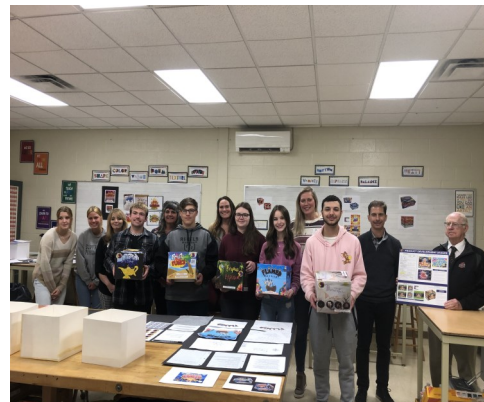
