#### **PARKING PERMITS**

ALL STUDENTS, INCLUDING CCCTC AND CCP STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PARK IN STUDENT LOT. THE PAC LOT IS ONLY FOR STAFF & VISITOR PARKING FOR THE 2023-24 SCHOOL YEAR.

Student Parking Forms are available online under the high school page, and should completed as soon as possible.

Students must have the forms authorized digitally by their parents, bring a copy of your valid driver's license, proof of insurance (copy for our records) and \$20.00 (cash or check payable to Crestview Schools) at the time of purchasing their permit. All student drivers must have a parking sticker and participate in the student random drug screening if they have not already done so as a student athlete.

# 12th Grade Meningitis Requirement

This letter is to inform you of the *Immunization Requirements* for students entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2023. Students are required to have: 2 doses of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) vaccine. If your child received the first dose of the vaccine after his/her 16<sup>th</sup> birthday, a second (2<sup>nd</sup>) dose is not required.

We must have proof of these immunization (s) in order for your child to begin 12<sup>th</sup> grade. If your child has already received these immunization (s), please send a copy of the record to the school as soon as possible.

If your child has not received these immunizations, please contact your healthcare provider as soon as possible to schedule an appointment. It is important to plan ahead as it may be difficult to get an appointment closer to the start of school in the fall.

The Immunization Record must be received before **August 21, 2023**. Records can be mailed, faxed (330-482-5369) or hand delivered to the office.
